HR 68	CHAMPAGNE	HEALTH CARE/FACILITIES Directs the Department of Health and Hospitals to promulgate and publish rules and regulations relative to pediatric day health care facilities
HR 94	BARROW (TBA)	HEALTH CARE/PROVIDERS Urges and requests the Department of Health and Hospitals to submit a state plan amendment to the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services to allow a home health care recipient to receive more than 50 reimbursable visits in a calendar year (Subject to rule suspension)
SCR 80	MOUNT	HEALTH CARE Creates the Louisiana Alzheimer's Disease Task Force.
SCR 83	JACKSON, L.	CHILDREN Requests state agencies to participate in BrightStart to coordinate policy, budget planning and services that support early childhood development.
SB 119	BROOME	HEALTH CARE Provides for the definition of "lifestyle modifications." (8/15/08)
SB 337	MICHOT	HEALTH SERVICES Provides for uncompensated care hospital payments. (8/15/08)
SB 418	MURRAY	FEDERAL PROGRAMS Requires physicians at certain facilities to render opinions for purposes of social security disability determinations. (8/15/08)
SB 660	NEVERS	FUNDS/FUNDING Creates the Child Poverty Prevention Council for Louisiana and the Child Poverty Prevention Fund. (7/1/08)
SB 701	MOUNT	HEALTH CARE Provides for integrated case management through the use of "No Wrong Door." (gov sig)
SB 762	CROWE	NURSING HOMES Provides that the owner of a nursing home operating prior to hurricanes Katrina and Rita whose facility was destroyed by one of these storms and whose license has been considered surrendered, shall be allowed to demonstrate a

failure to receive notice and the ability to qualify for the re-issuance of the pre-storm license. (8/15/08)

SB 765 **MICHOT**

MEDICAID Provides relative to minimizing the impact of budget adjustments upon hospitals qualifying for Medicaid rate maximization. (gov sig)

SB 810 **MOUNT**

HEALTH CARE Provides for Alzheimer's training requirements for certain employees of adult residential care homes and long-term care facilities. (gov sig)
