- SCR 92 MARIONNEAUX (TBA) HEALTH/HOSPITALS DEPT** Requests the Department of Health and Hospitals to investigate the high rates of cancer in Livonia. **(Subject to rule suspension)**
- SCR 93 BROOME (TBA) NURSES** Requests the Nursing Supply and Demand Commission, the Louisiana State University System, and the Southern University System to study whether any educational obstacles exist which prevent a licensed practical nurse from becoming a licensed registered nurse. **(Subject to rule suspension)**
- SCR 98 CASSIDY (TBA) HEALTH CARE** Creates the Healthy People of Louisiana Task Force. **(Subject to rule suspension)**
- SB 33 CHEEK (TBA) HEALTH/ACC INSURANCE** Provides for requirements of health insurers for the Department of Health and Hospital's right to recover in Medicaid claims. (8/15/08) **(Subject to rule suspension)**
- SB 402 CASSIDY MEDICAID** Provides for the allocation of uncompensated care payments. (gov sig)
- SB 615 JACKSON, L. CHILDREN** Provides relative to the Children's Cabinet, extending the sunset on the cabinet and the board and revising the preparation and submission of the children's budget. (8/15/08)
