HB 278	ST. GERMAIN	ETHICS Provides an exception for certain activities by or on behalf of an agency to restrictions on giving food, drink, and refreshment to public servants
HB 290	DIXON	ETHICS/BOARD Provides relative to the enforcement of laws within the jurisdiction of the Board of Ethics
HB 432	HINES	ETHICS Restricts certain persons from giving a public servant food, drink, and refreshment valued at more than \$50 in a 24-hour period
HB 487	LORUSSO (TBA)	LEGISLATIVE SESSIONS (Constitutional Amendment) Provides relative to the conduct of legislative sessions (Subject to Rule Suspension)
HB 779	ST. GERMAIN	ETHICS Removes certain provisions requiring certain public servants and affiliated persons and entities to file annual reports with the Board of Ethics relative to certain contracts with state government
HB 853	TUCKER	ETHICS/BOARD Provides relative to the enforcement of laws under the jurisdiction of the Board of Ethics
HB 906	HUTTER	ETHICS Requires the Board of Ethics to send information regarding the complaint immediately to the accused
HB 911	GALLOT	ETHICS/CODE Provides relative to the acceptance of admission to certain events by public servants
HB 912	ST. GERMAIN	ETHICS/CODE Provides relative to the acceptance of admission to certain events by public servants

HB 921	GALLOT	ETHICS/CODE Provides relative to the acceptance of admission to certain events by elected officials
HB 947	HUTTER	ETHICS Allows a public servant to accept complimentary admission to a fundraising event held by or for the benefit of an educational institution, excluding professional, semi-professional, or collegiate sporting events
HB 991	HUTTER	ETHICS Allows a public servant to accept complimentary or discounted admission to, transportation to, and lodging related to educational, informational, or professional development seminars and conferences
HB 999	ELLINGTON	ETHICS Provides relative to the restrictions on food, drink, and refreshment
HB 1002	GALLOT	ETHICS Provides relative to certain prohibited contracts
HB 1003	GALLOT	ETHICS/FINANCIAL DISCLOS Provides relative to certain prohibited contracts
HB 1181	LORUSSO (TBA)	ETHICS/CODE Excludes certain members of the National Guard from the definition of "public employee" for purposes of the Code of Governmental Ethics (Subject to Rule Suspension)
