| <b>HCR 96</b> | <b>JONES, ROSALIND (TBA)</b> | <b>HEALTH/DHH</b> Directs DHH and the Louisiana Commission on Law Enforcement and Administration of Criminal Justice to study the effects of substance abuse on recidivism rates <b>(Subject to rule suspension)</b>                             |
| <b>HB 856</b> | <b>ARMES</b>                 | <b>HOSPITALS</b> Conditions the issuance of a license to an acute care hospital on providing emergency room services in certain rural areas  |
