<b>HB 640</b>	<b>LORUSSO</b>	<b>MALPRACTICE/MEDICAL</b> Provides for the qualifications of physicians as expert witnesses in medical malpractice actions
<b>HB 658</b>	<b>LORUSSO</b>	<b>MALPRACTICE/MEDICAL</b> Provides procedures for certain malpractice claims
<b>HB 689</b>	<b>EDWARDS</b>	<b>MALPRACTICE/MEDICAL</b> Excludes economic loss from medical malpractice cap
<b>HB 826</b>	<b>LORUSSO</b>	<b>MALPRACTICE/MEDICAL</b> (Constitutional Amendment) Provides relative to medical malpractice claims
<b>SB 161</b>	<b>JACKSON, L.</b>	<b>CHILDREN</b> Provides relative to income assignment orders. (8/15/08)
<b>SB 260</b>	<b>JACKSON, L.</b>	<b>CHILDREN</b> Provides relative to acknowledgments of judgments and paternity.
<b>SB 301</b>	<b>CHAISSON</b>	<b>LIABILITY</b> Provides immunity for certain medical personnel during evacuation or treatment of patients. (gov sig)
<b>SB 330</b>	<b>CHAISSON</b>	<b>LIABILITY</b> Provides relative to limitation of liability for medical services during a declared state of emergency. (gov sig)
<b>SB 721</b>	<b>CHAISSON (TBA)</b>	<b>EVIDENCE</b> Provides for challenges to the admissibility of blood alcohol concentration test results into evidence. (gov sig)( <b>Subject to Rule Suspension</b> )
