SCR 6	DONAHUE	<b>ELECTION CODE</b> Establishes a special committee to study the Election Code.
SCR 17	GRAY	<b>SECRETARY OF STATE</b> Requests the secretary of state to study the impact of voting machine malfunctions on voting and to study the feasibility of using backup paper ballots at polls on election day.
SCR 35	MCPHERSON	<b>MOTOR VEHICLES</b> Creates a special study committee to study procedures on creating a special EMS designation.
SCR 78	GRAY	<b>LEGIS POWERS/FUNCTIONS</b> Expresses legislative support for the creation of a joint legislative Substance Abuse and Mental Health Caucus.
SB 58	KOSTELKA	<b>REGISTRARS OF VOTERS</b> Provides relative to the annual canvass of registered voters. (1/1/09)
SB 63	KOSTELKA	<b>VOTERS/VOTING</b> Prohibits the registrar of voters and Department of State from disclosing registration data received from another state pursuant to cooperative agreement and geographical coding of addresses of registered voters. (gov sig)
SB 210	MARIONNEAUX	<b>APPOINTED OFFICIALS</b> Provides that certain persons appointed to boards and commissions be reconfirmed each legislative term. (8/15/08)

SB 232	MOUNT	<b>APPOINTED OFFICIALS</b> Constitutional amendment to provide for a three-consecutive-term limit for positions on certain constitutionally-provided boards and commissions. (2/3-CA13s1(A))
SB 233	MOUNT	<b>APPOINTED OFFICIALS</b> Provides term limits for members of certain boards and commissions. (See Act)
SB 258	GAUTREAUX, N. (TBA)	<b>CHILDREN</b> Provides relative to the Department of Social Services. (Subject to Rule Suspension)
SB 343	DUPLESSIS	<b>ECONOMIC DEVELOP DEPT</b> Extends the sunset for confidentiality of economic development negotiations from July 1, 2008, to July 1, 2012. (gov sig)
SB 363	NEVERS	<b>CIVIC EDUCATION</b> Provides for confidentiality of certain information on the applications of minors submitted for membership on the Legislative Youth Advisory Council and authorizes the designation of certain youth to serve in an advisory, nonvoting capacity to the council. (gov sig)
SB 493	MCPHERSON	<b>TRANSPORTATION/DEV DEPT</b> Provides for certain records of sensitive security information or critical infrastructure information of DOTD. (7/1/08)
