| HB 317 | GREENE | TAX/SALES-USE, STATE (Constitutional Amendment) Provides relative to the sales and use tax exemption on food for home consumption (<i>Technical Review Only</i>) |
| HB 903 | ARNOLD (TBA) | TAX/AD VALOREM TAX (Constitutional Amendment) Limits the power of taxing authorities with governing authorities which are not elected to increase millage rates without voter approval and requires elections to approve the levy or renewal of property taxes of such unelected authorities to be held only on the same dates as gubernatorial and congressional primary elections (<i>Subject to Rule Suspension</i>) (<i>Technical Review Only</i>) |
| SCR 78 | MURRAY (TBA) | ATTORNEYS Requests the Louisiana State Law Institute to study and recommend guidelines to clarify the professional duties of attorneys for fiduciaries. (<i>Subject to Rule Suspension</i>) |
| SB 172 | QUINN | OWNERSHIP Provides relative to ownership of certain reclaimed lands lost through erosion, compaction, subsidence, or sea level rise. (gov sig) |
| SB 183 | APPEL (TBA) | COLLEGES/UNIVERSITIES Constitutional amendment to exempt postsecondary education tuition and fee amounts at public institutions from the requirements for imposing and increasing fees. (2/3-CA13s1(A)) (<i>Subject to Rule Suspension</i>) (<i>Technical Review Only</i>) |
