HB 495	DIXON	EDUCATION ACCOUNTABILITY Exempts a school that meets specified criteria from being transferred to the Recovery School District
HB 571	NORTON (TBA)	STUDENT/DISCIPLINE Prohibits corporal punishment in public elementary and secondary schools (Subject to Rule Suspension)
HCR 53	HUTTER	CURRICULA Requests BESE to develop and implement an age-appropriate unit on hurricane awareness for students in each grade in all local public school systems
HCR 54	HUTTER	TEACHERS Requests the state Dept. of Education to compile statistics relative to where public school teachers certified in the past 10 years received degrees and report to education committees
HCR 101	SIMON	HIGHER ED/GRADUATE Requests instruction on principles of Universal Design and Visitability in certain graduate degree programs
HCR 165	DIXON	EDUCATION ACCOUNTABILITY Requests BESE to implement a policy to provide for an alternate method of assessing the overall performance of alternative schools
SB 223	CLAITOR	STUDENTS Provides relative to the removal of students from the classroom for certain inappropriate behavior and for parental notification and involvement. (8/15/09)
SB 259	KOSTELKA	CURRICULA Provides for the high school career option program. (gov sig)
SB 285	NEVERS (TBA)	POSTSECONDARY ED Provides for a comprehensive system of articulation and transfer of credit between and among public secondary and

postsecondary educational institutions. (gov sig)
