| HB 176 | POPE | CURRICULA/DRIVER ED Permits a child who is in at least the ninth grade and is less than 15 years of age to participate in the classroom instruction component of the driver education program operated by BESE and the state Dept. of Education |
| HB 461 | AUBERT | COLLEGES/UNIVERSITIES Provides relative to the dissemination on the campus of a public postsecondary education institution of certain information concerning consumer credit cards to undergraduate students |
| HB 495 | DIXON | EDUCATION ACCOUNTABILITY Exempts a school that meets specified criteria from being transferred to the Recovery School District |
| HB 498 | DOERGE | SCHOOLS/LOCAL SUPERINTDT Permits a local superintendent of schools to provide services, contractual or otherwise, to the state Dept. of Education, BESE, or the RSD, or any combination of such entities |
| HB 570 | HOFFMANN (TBA) | SCHOOLS/EMPLOYEES Provides relative to policies, procedures, and practices at public elementary and secondary schools concerning electronic communications by an employee at a school to a student at that school (Subject to Rule Suspension) |
| HB 590 | BARROW (TBA) | SCHOOLS/ENROLLMENT Requires public school governing authorities to ensure that children in foster care are allowed to remain enrolled in the same public schools in which they were enrolled when entering foster care (Subject to Rule Suspension) |
| HB 731 | DOWNS (TBA) | STUDENT/SCH ATTENDANCE Provides relative to the habitual absence and tardiness of students, including penalties for violations by parents and legal guardians/custodians of such students (Subject to Rule Suspension) |
| HB 752 | BADON, AUSTIN (TBA) | SCHOOLS/DISTRICTS Allows the Recovery School District (RSD) to enroll certain students in a virtual or cyber school or educational program |

HB 821 CARTER, STEVE (TBA)

SCHOOLS/FINANCE-MFP Provides relative to the allocation and reporting of certain education funding (**Subject to Rule Suspension**)
