| HB 166 | GULLORY, MICKEY | INSURERS/TAXES Provides relative to the assessment on fire insurance premiums dedicated to training of fire and emergency personnel |
| HB 192 | ABRAMSON | TAX/SEVERANCE TAX Reduces the severance tax levied after payout on certain oil production within a CO2 tertiary recovery program |
| HB 251 | GREENE | TAX/SALES-USE-EXEMPT Clarifies references to manufactured, mobile, modular, and factory built homes for purposes of the tax exemption on the sale of such property |
| HB 302 | GREENE | TAX/SALES-USE, ST-EXEMPT Provides relative to the effectiveness of the state sales and use tax exemption on the purchase of symphony organization admission tickets |
| HB 307 | GREENE | TAX/SALES-USE, ST-EXEMPT Provides relative to the state sales and use tax exemption on food sold for preparation and consumption in the home |
| HB 317 | GREENE | TAX/SALES-USE, STATE (Constitutional Amendment) Provides relative to the sales and use tax exemption on food for home consumption |
| HB 320 | GALLOT (TBA) | TAX EXEMPTIONS Authorizes an exemption from state and local sales taxes for certain machinery and equipment (Subject to Rule Suspension) |
| HB 338 | GREENE (TBA) | TAX/INCOME TAX Provides relative to the tax deduction for fees and other educational expenses for a quality public education (Subject to Rule Suspension) |
| HB 475 | GREENE | TAX/CORPINCOME Provides for revenue from broadcasting film or radio programming |
| HB 745 | PEARSON | TAX/SALES-USE, LOCAL Authorizes a taxing authority to pay its contract auditors on a contingency basis |
