| <b>HB 51</b>  | <b>LEGER</b>    | <b>TAX/INCOME-CREDIT</b> Increases the amount of the individual income tax credit for the installation of a wind or solar energy system and authorizes the credit to apply to systems installed on commercial property                                                    |
| <b>HB 85</b>  | <b>DIXON</b>    | <b>TAX CREDITS</b> Authorizes the wind or solar energy systems tax credit to apply to commercial or business property                                                                                                                                                     |
| <b>HB 86</b>  | <b>LABRUZZO</b> | <b>TAX CREDITS</b> Authorizes the wind or solar energy systems tax credit to apply to commercial or business property and provides for the transferability of such credit                                                                                                 |

| <b>HB 258</b> | <b>LIGI</b>     | <b>TAX CREDITS</b> Authorizes a corporate income tax credit for motor fuel dealers, wholesalers, and terminal facilities for costs of purchase and installation of alternate gas generated power source equipment if purchased from and installed by a Louisiana business |
| <b>HB 303</b> | <b>GREENE</b>   | <b>TAX/INCOME-CREDIT</b> Authorizes the wind or solar energy systems tax credit to apply to commercial or business property                                                                                                                                               |
| <b>HB 324</b> | <b>GREENE</b>   | <b>TAX/INCOME TAX</b> Authorizes an individual income tax credit for the purchase of a generator for a residence                                                                                                                                                          |
| <b>HB 326</b> | <b>BARROW</b>   | <b>TAX CREDITS</b> Authorizes a refundable individual income tax credit for taxpayers 62 years of age and older for prescription drug expenses                                                                                                                            |

<b>HB 360</b>	<b>HARRISON</b>	<b>TAX CREDITS</b> Provides for continuation of the Brownfields Investor Tax Credit program
<b>HB 424</b>	<b>PEARSON</b>	<b>TAX/SALES-USE, STATE</b> Authorizes a state sales and use tax exemption for the purchase of a new motor vehicle with a fuel efficiency rating of at least 40 m.p.g.
<b>HB 533</b>	<b>WHITE</b>	<b>TAX/SALES-USE-EXEMPT</b> Authorizes a state and local sales and use tax exemption for the purchase of a generator
<b>HB 550</b>	<b>ERNST</b>	<b>TAX CREDITS</b> Extends the wind or solar energy systems tax credit to commercial or business property
<b>HB 578</b>	<b>RICHMOND</b>	<b>TAX/INCOME-INDIV/EXEMPT</b> Increases tax credits for employment of certain persons related to the prevention of recidivism by persons released from incarceration
<b>HB 750</b>	<b>GUILLORY, ELBERT</b>	<b>TAX CREDITS</b> Creates tax credit for employers of skilled craftsman who are graduates of the Dept. of Public Safety and Corrections' inmate rehabilitation and workforce development program
