HCR 10	ANDERS	WEAPONS/FIREARMS Urges safety in the use and storage of weapons
HB 27	WOOTON	WEAPONS/FIREARMS Authorizes concealed handgun permit holders to carry concealed weapons on campuses
HB 44	LAFONTA	WEAPONS/FIREARMS Creates the crime of discharging a firearm at a public event
HB 82	BILLIOT	WEAPONS/FIREARMS Adds a definition of a firearm for purposes of the crime of illegally carrying or possession of a firearm by certain convicted felons
HB 177	MILLS	CONTROLLED SUBSTANCES Designates compounds containing pseudoephedrine, ephedrine, and phenylpropanolamine as Schedule V controlled dangerous substances and requires transactions involving those products be monitored by the Prescription Monitoring Program
HB 312	ABRAMSON	WEAPONS/FIREARMS Adds additional predicate offense to crime prohibiting certain felons from possessing firearms
HB 387	RICHMOND	WEAPONS/FIREARMS Bans possession of certain assault weapons
HB 510	ELLINGTON	EXPLOSIVES Amends definition of explosives handler and license holder
HB 523	ERNST	WEAPONS/FIREARMS Provides for increased penalties for illegal carrying of a weapon at a parade
HB 703	KATZ	SOCIAL SERVICES DEPT Authorizes the Dept. of Social Services to conduct criminal background checks on certain persons
HB 715	LEGER	JUVENILE PROCEDURE Provides with respect to parole eligibility of certain juvenile offenders
