| HCR 6 | DANAHAY | CIVIL SERVICE/COMMISSION Requests the State Civil Service Commission to adopt certain rules affecting layoff procedures, job classifications, and merit increases |
| HCR 89 | BARROW | CIVIL SERVICE Requests all civil service systems to utilize electronic methods of testing and to report to the legislature progress towards that goal |
| HCR 90 | BILLIOT | LEGISLATION/BILLS Provides for electronic mail notification of instruments referred to committees |
| HCR 98 | DANAHAY (TBA) | STATE AGENCIES Provides for the Dept. of State Civil Service to compile and report information regarding Performance Planning and Review (PPR) and pay increases of state employees to the legislature and certain committees (Subject to Rule Suspension) |
| HCR 100 | DIXON (TBA) | CIVIL SERVICE DEPARTMENT Requests the Dept. of State Civil Service to study and the State Civil Service Commission to consider imposing time limits for investigating and taking action against an employee (Subject to Rule Suspension) |
| HB 243 | ABRAMSON | ETHICS Requires disclosure by certain officials of information relative to employment and appointment of campaign contributors |
| HB 347 | DOWNS | INSURANCE DEPARTMENT Provides that certain health information in possession of the Dept. of Insurance is confidential |
| HB 380 | CROMER | TAX/AD VALOREM TAX Adds requirements for public notice of millage "roll forwards" which are not subject to voter approval |
| HB 504 | LIGI | SCHOOLS/BOARDS Provides term limits for members of the Jefferson Parish School Board |
| HB 508 | GREENE | PUBLIC OFFICIALS Requires annual performance evaluations for certain public officials |

- HB 511 HARRISON** **STUDENT/TUITION** (Constitutional Amendment) Exempts public postsecondary education tuition amounts and mandatory fees from requirements for imposing a new or increasing an existing tax or fee
- HB 595 DANAHAAY** **PUBLIC EMPLOYEES** Provides for a required education program for certain unclassified officials and employees and ties compensation to the conduct of certain duties
- HB 826 GALLOT** **ETHICS** Provides for the organization of and assignment of functions and duties to the staff of the Board of Ethics
- HB 852 SMILEY** **BOARDS/COMMISSIONS** Abolishes boards and commissions and like entities
