HCR 76	HARRISON	COURTS/JUSTICE OF PEACE Requests that the attorney general study the training requirements of justices of the peace over the age of 70
HB 368	BURRELL	SALES/TOBACCO TRADE Provides relative to cigarettes sold from self-service displays
HB 524	HOFFMANN	HEALTH Authorizes the district attorney to convene a multi-disciplinary team to aid pregnant women who are abusing alcohol and drugs
HB 555	CHANDLER	COURTS/COURT REPORTERS Exempts specified court reporters from certification requirements
HB 574	RICHMOND	COURTS/DISTRICT Authorizes a division of a district court to have specialized subject matter jurisdiction including a violent crimes or homicide division or section and the creation of a probation program for a mental health division
HB 606	PERRY	HOMELAND SECURITY Provides for the prohibition of price gouging after a declared state of emergency
HB 712	SMITH, GARY (TBA)	JUDGES/JUSTICE OF PEACE Provides that a justice of the peace shall not have the authority to issue a warrant of arrest (Subject to Rule Suspension)
HB 758	DIXON	ATTORNEY GENERAL Authorizes the attorney general to enter into contingency fee contracts
HB 840	WHITE	HOMELAND SECURITY Requires each parish to create an advisory committee on emergency management
SB 27	MARTINY (TBA)	JUDGES Provides authority for certain federal judges to perform marriage ceremonies from October 1, 2009 through October 31, 2009. (8/15/2009) (Subject to Rule Suspension)
