<b>HCR 8</b>	<b>HARDY</b>	<b>FEDERAL PROGRAMS</b> Expresses legislative intent to certify all funds available under the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009
<b>HCR 9</b>	<b>RICHMOND</b>	<b>UNEMPLOYMENT COMP</b> Expresses the legislature's desire to accept funding allocated in the unemployment compensation modernization provision of the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009
<b>HCR 50</b>	<b>HENRY</b>	<b>LABOR/COLLECTIVE BARGAIN</b> Memorializes congress to oppose the Employee Free Choice Act
<b>HCR 92</b>	<b>DIXON</b>	<b>LABOR</b> Memorializes congress to pass the Employee Free Choice Act
<b>HB 562</b>	<b>LEBAS</b>	<b>WORKERS COMPENSATION</b> Requires a payor to notify health care providers when a case has been settled
<b>HB 610</b>	<b>RICHMOND</b>	<b>UNEMPLOYMENT COMP</b> Expands unemployment compensation benefits
<b>HB 615</b>	<b>JONES, SAM</b>	<b>UNEMPLOYMENT COMP</b> Expands unemployment compensation benefits under certain conditions
<b>HB 658</b>	<b>ROY</b>	<b>WORKERS COMPENSATION</b> Provides relative to the prescriptive period for claiming workers' compensation benefits
<b>HB 705</b>	<b>NORTON</b>	<b>EMPLOYMENT/WAGES</b> Creates the Equal Pay for Women Act
<b>HB 706</b>	<b>PONTI</b>	<b>WORKERS COMPENSATION</b> Provides relative to the scope and operation of Louisiana's workers' compensation system
<b>HB 799</b>	<b>JACKSON, M.</b>	<b>UNEMPLOYMENT COMP</b> Establishes penalties for failure to file any payroll report
<b>HB 800</b>	<b>JACKSON, M.</b>	<b>UNEMPLOYMENT COMP</b> Provides relative to the prompt determination of claims
