<b>HB 11</b>	<b>GUILLORY</b>	<b>COURTS/MAYORS</b> Authorizes an increase in court costs for municipal ordinance violations in the mayor's court in the town of Basile
<b>HB 21</b>	<b>THIERRY</b>	<b>CLERKS OF COURT</b> Provides relative to filing and recordation fees for the receipt of electronic records by the clerk of court's office in the 27 <sup>th</sup> Judicial District Court (St. Landry Parish)
<b>HB 110</b>	<b>JONES, ROSALIND</b>	<b>JUDGES/MUNICIPAL</b> Increases the amount of annual vacation of a judge of the city court of Monroe
<b>HB 111</b>	<b>CHANDLER</b>	<b>SHERIFFS</b> Provides for the payment of insurance premiums for retired sheriffs and deputy sheriffs of the LaSalle Parish Sheriff's Office
<b>HB 113</b>	<b>CHANDLER</b>	<b>CLERKS OF COURT</b> Provides for the payment of medical insurance premiums of certain retirees of the clerk of court's offices in the parishes of Grant, LaSalle, and Winn
<b>HB 125</b>	<b>RITCHIE</b>	<b>COURTS/CITY</b> Provides for an additional court cost in the City Court of Bogalusa
<b>HB 163</b>	<b>SMITH, GARY</b>	<b>INSURANCE/GROUP-SHERIFFS</b> Provides for payment of group insurance for retired sheriffs and deputy sheriffs of the St. Charles Parish Sheriff's Office
<b>HB 174</b>	<b>EDWARDS</b>	<b>SUNSET LAW</b> Re-creates the Dept. of Veterans Affairs
<b>HB 183</b>	<b>BURNS, HENRY</b>	<b>SHERIFFS</b> Provides for the investment and use of monies in the Bossier Parish Retired Employees Insurance Fund
<b>HB 214</b>	<b>KLECKLEY</b>	<b>CIVIL/PROCEDURE</b> Provides for electronic filing and storage of documents

<b>HB 235</b>	<b>WOOTON</b>	<b>SHERIFFS/DEPUTY</b> Authorizes retired sheriff's deputies to purchase their weapons
<b>HB 243</b>	<b>WOOTON</b>	<b>SHERIFFS</b> Provides with respect to compensation for employees of the Plaquemines Parish Sheriff's Office
<b>HB 263</b>	<b>BALDONE</b>	<b>CHILDREN/SUPPORT</b> Provides relative to the transfer of child support actions
<b>HB 266</b>	<b>FOIL</b>	<b>COURTS</b> Provides relative to the retention of certain court records
<b>HB 283</b>	<b>ARNOLD</b>	<b>TRAFFIC/VIOLATIONS</b> Provides that certain traffic violations be heard in certain courts
<b>HB 289</b>	<b>HARDY</b>	<b>JUDGES</b> (Constitutional Amendment) Provides with respect to domicile requirements for certain judges
<b>HB 332</b>	<b>NOWLIN</b>	<b>LIBRARIES</b> Provides relative to the Natchitoches Parish Law Library Commission
<b>HB 419</b>	<b>BARROW</b>	<b>LAW ENFORCE/OFFICERS</b> Requires law enforcement officials to undergo training on the use of tasers
<b>HB 445</b>	<b>JONES, ROSALIND</b>	<b>COURTS/CITY</b> Increases the civil jurisdictional amount for the City Court of Monroe
<b>HB 509</b>	<b>LORUSSO</b>	<b>COURTS/MUNICIPAL</b> Provides for a special environmental docket for the Municipal Court of New Orleans
<b>HB 571</b>	<b>SCHRODER (TBA)</b>	<b>CRIMINAL/PROCEDURE</b> Amends provision of law regarding surrender of defendant ( <b>Subject to Rule Suspension</b> )
<b>HB 690</b>	<b>MONICA</b>	<b>COURTS/JUSTICE OF PEACE</b> Authorizes certain constables to have parishwide jurisdiction
<b>HB 801</b>	<b>LAMBERT</b>	<b>JUDGES/SUPREME COURT</b> (Constitutional Amendment) Provides that the term of office for justices of the supreme court is six years
<b>HB 900</b>	<b>GALLOT</b>	<b>POLICE/STATE</b> Transfers capitol police to the Department of Public Safety and Corrections
<b>HB 1113</b>	<b>RICHMOND</b>	<b>MUNICIPALITIES</b> Provides relative to appeals of decisions of local ethics review boards
