<b>HB 46</b>	<b>HUTTER</b>	<b>CURRICULA</b> Requires instruction with respect to dating violence in public schools
<b>HB 303</b>	<b>HENRY</b>	<b>STUDENT/HOME STUDY</b> Provides relative to eligibility of certain home study students to participate in interscholastic athletics at secondary schools that are members of the LHSAA
<b>HB 399</b>	<b>PEARSON</b>	<b>TEACHERS/LEAVE</b> Exempts, under specified fiscal conditions, a local school board from complying with the requirement that the board grant certain requests for sabbatical leave
<b>HB 400</b>	<b>PEARSON</b>	<b>SCHOOLS/EMPLOYEES</b> Exempts, under specified fiscal conditions, a local school board from complying with the requirement that the board permit certain employees to take up to 90 days of extended sick leave
<b>HB 402</b>	<b>PEARSON</b>	<b>HIGHER ED/BD REGENTS</b> Requires the Board of Regents to broadcast on the Internet the audio and video of all board and committee meetings conducted in Baton Rouge and to archive the audio and video of such meetings
<b>HB 403</b>	<b>PEARSON</b>	<b>BESE</b> Requires BESE to broadcast on the Internet the audio and video of all board and committee meetings conducted in Baton Rouge and to archive the audio and video of such meetings
<b>HB 425</b>	<b>HOFFMANN</b>	<b>TEACHERS/CERTIFICATION</b> Provides relative to the certification of principals and authorizes certain fees related to certification of the teachers, principals, and other educators
<b>HB 443</b>	<b>HUTTER</b>	<b>COLLEGES/UNIVERSITIES</b> Provides relative to campuses designated as part of the Louisiana Technical College
<b>HB 709</b>	<b>BROSSETT</b>	<b>EDUCATION</b> Provides relative to the New Orleans Center for the Creative Arts (NOCCA)
<b>HB 732</b>	<b>NORTON</b>	<b>STUDENT/DISCIPLINE</b> Prohibits corporal punishment in public elementary and secondary schools

<b>HB 1180</b>	<b>SMITH, PATRICIA</b>	<b>TEXTBOOKS/MATERIALS</b> Authorizes local public school boards to use state funds to purchase instructional technology and related hardware
<b>HB 388</b>	<b>SMITH, PATRICIA</b>	<b>SCHOOLS/CHARTER</b> Provides relative to teachers transferring to a charter school from a local school system
<b>HB 580</b>	<b>SMITH, PATRICIA</b>	<b>EDUCATION/SPECIAL</b> Authorizes certain special schools to share services and functions under certain conditions
<b>HB 934</b>	<b>NOWLIN (TBA)</b>	<b>COLLEGES/UNIVERSITIES</b> Provides for additional purposes for which public postsecondary education management boards shall use revenues from oil, gas, and mineral leases ( <b>Subject to Rule Suspension</b> )
