| HB 62 | ABRAMSON | LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR Prohibits a person appointed to fill a vacancy in the office of lieutenant governor when the unexpired term exceeds one year from being a candidate in the election to fill the remainder of the term |
| HB 247 | GREENE | PUBLIC PRINTING Eliminates requirement that the Acts of the legislature be published in the official journal of the state |
| HB 248 | GREENE | PUBLIC PRINTING (Constitutional Amendment) Eliminates requirement that the Acts of the legislature be published in the official journal of the state |
| HB 309 | GREENE | PUBLIC PRINTING Provides relative to certain public printing requirements |
| HB 318 | GREENE | PUBLIC PRINTING Provides relative to needs assessments for public printing |
| HB 476 | GREENE | PUBLIC PRINTING Provides relative to public printing requirements |
| HB 477 | GREENE | PUBLIC PRINTING Prohibits pictures of public officials or employees above a certain size in public documents |
| HB 610 | KATZ | PUBLIC RECORDS Extends public records exemption to all practitioners licensed by the La. State Board of Medical Examiners |
| HB 625 | BARROW | ELECTIONS/RECALL Provides relative to recall elections |
| HB 632 | LORUSSO | PRINTING Provides relative to reports required to be submitted to the legislature |
| HB 650 | EDWARDS | ELECTED OFFICIALS/STATEW Provides that a statewide elected official who takes certain actions seeking another office has ipso facto resigned from office |
| HB 722 | GREENE | PUBLIC PRINTING Relative to distribution of the Acts of the legislature by the secretary of state |

| HB 765 | GREENE | OFFICIAL JOURNALS Changes the "Official Journal of the State" from a newspaper to the Legislature's website |
| HB 789 | CROMER | SECRETARY OF STATE Modifies the definition of "Official Journal of the State" to include the legislature's website for purposes related to publication of Acts of the legislature |
| HB 935 | TALBOT | PUBLIC MEETINGS Provides for notice of public meetings |
| HB 939 | KATZ | PUBLIC MEETINGS Allows agencies responsible for licensing health care professionals to hold an executive session following an administrative adjudication hearing |
| HB 1162 | RICHARD | ELECTIONS/RECALL Provides for procedures relative to recall elections |
| HB 1212 | ARNOLD | OFFICIAL JOURNALS Relative to official journals and electronic publication |
| HCR 57 | LORUSSO | U.S. CONSTITUTION Applies to congress to call a convention pursuant to Article V of the U.S. Constitution to propose an amendment regarding a presidential line item veto for appropriation bills |
| HCR 59 | LORUSSO | U.S. CONSTITUTION Applies to congress to call a convention pursuant to Article V of the U.S. Constitution to propose an amendment regarding a requirement that bills be confined to a single object and a prohibition on amendments that are not germane to the bill as introduced |
| HCR 62 | LORUSSO | U.S. CONSTITUTION Applies to congress to call a convention pursuant to Article V of the U.S. Constitution to propose an amendment regarding a requirement for a supermajority vote to levy a new tax, increase an existing tax, or repeal an existing tax exemption |
| HCR 63 | LORUSSO | U.S. CONSTITUTION Applies to congress to call a convention pursuant to Article V of the U.S. Constitution to propose an amendment regarding term limits for members of congress |
| HCR 64 | LORUSSO | U.S. CONSTITUTION Applies to congress to call a convention pursuant to Article V of the U.S. Constitution to propose an amendment regarding a limitation on the authority of congress to pass legislation pursuant to the general welfare clause in Article I, Section 8 of the U.S. Constitution |
| HCR 65 | LORUSSO | U.S. CONSTITUTION Applies to congress to call a convention pursuant to Article V of the U.S. Constitution to propose an amendment regarding a requirement to reduce the federal debt through annual appropriations |

HCR 66 LORUSSO

U.S. CONSTITUTION Applies to congress to call a convention pursuant to Article V of the U.S. Constitution to propose an amendment regarding an overall spending limitation on the federal budget


