HB 525	FANNIN	<b>TAX/INCOME-INDIV/RETURN</b> Requires DPS&C and the Board of Parole to participate in the offset program established within the Dept. of Revenue to collect past due probation or parole fees
HB 756	CHAMPAGNE	<b>PARDON</b> Provides relative to compensation and benefits of, certain restrictions on, and disclosure requirements for members of the Board of Pardons
HB 918	SMITH, PATRICIA (TBA)	CORRECTIONS Authorizes earning of additional good time for participation in certain rehabilitation and treatment programs (Subject to Rule Suspension)
HB 940	MONTOUCET	CRIMINAL/JURY TRIALS (Constitutional Amendment) Permits criminal defendants in certain cases to waive trial by jury with the consent of the prosecutor and court approval
HB 946	RICHMOND	<b>PAROLE</b> Authorizes geriatric parole for certain inmates
