<b>HCR 48</b>	<b>RICHMOND (TBA)</b>	<b>COURTS/SUPREME COURT</b> Urges the Judicial Council to recommend guidelines and rules to the Supreme Court of La. for the qualification and standards on the use of court interpreters ( <b>Subject to Rule Suspension</b> )
<b>HCR 70</b>	<b>PUGH</b>	<b>SPECIAL DAY/WEEK/MONTH</b> Recognizes La. Irish Week in March in celebration of the state's rich Irish heritage
<b>HCR 71</b>	<b>RICHMOND</b>	<b>INSURANCE/HEALTH-ACCID</b> Directs La.'s attorney general to withdraw from the suit challenging the Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act of 2010 on constitutional grounds
<b>HCR 86</b>	<b>EDWARDS</b>	<b>VETERANS</b> Directs the Department of Veterans Affairs to distribute medals to recipients in the manner requested by the recipient
<b>HB 108</b>	<b>BARRAS</b>	<b>COURTS/CITY</b> Increases the civil jurisdictional amount in dispute in the City Court of Jeanerette and the City Court of New Iberia
<b>HB 124</b>	<b>JONES, ROSALIND</b>	<b>JUDGES/MUNICIPAL</b> Authorizes the use of certain civil filing fees to supplement salaries of certain court employees and judges and to purchase equipment and supplies
<b>HB 419</b>	<b>BARROW</b>	<b>LAW ENFORCE/OFFICERS</b> Requires law enforcement officials to undergo training on the use of tasers
<b>HB 429</b>	<b>CHANDLER</b>	<b>COURTS/COURT REPORTERS</b> Exempts certain court reporters from certification requirements
<b>HB 634</b>	<b>BARROW</b>	<b>COURTS/MAYORS</b> Restricts the authority of the mayor as to the length of the probationary period he may impose for violation of a municipal ordinance
<b>HB 801</b>	<b>LAMBERT</b>	<b>JUDGES/SUPREME COURT</b> (Constitutional Amendment) Provides that the term of office for justices of the supreme court is six years

<b>HB 907</b>	<b>ARNOLD</b>	<b>ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE PERMT</b> Prohibits the issuance of permits for dealers in beverages of low alcoholic content to certain manufacturers
<b>HB 980</b>	<b>ABRAMSON</b>	<b>CRIMINAL/PROCEDURE</b> Provides relative to the interviewing of crime victims and witnesses
<b>HB 986</b>	<b>ABRAMSON</b>	<b>CRIMINAL/PROCEDURE</b> Provides relative to the rights of minor victims and victims of sex offenses
<b>HB 995</b>	<b>HOWARD</b>	<b>ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES</b> Provides for special local option alcohol elections for a municipality
<b>HB 1013</b>	<b>RICHMOND</b>	<b>COURTS</b> Establishes the workforce development sentencing pilot project program in the Orleans Parish Criminal District Court and the Forty-First JDC
<b>HB 1017</b>	<b>WADDELL</b>	<b>COURTS/JUSTICE OF PEACE</b> Provides with respect to concurrent jurisdiction of justice of the peace courts and city courts
<b>HB 1114</b>	<b>GREENE</b>	<b>COURTS/COURT REPORTERS</b> Provides with respect to court reporters
<b>HB 1214</b>	<b>WHITE</b>	<b>HOMELAND SECURITY</b> Establishes an Intrastate Mutual Aid Compact
<b>HB 1218</b>	<b>GREENE</b>	<b>CLERKS OF COURT</b> Requires the clerks of court to remit unused funds or to demand payment for costs in civil matters within a certain period of time
<b>HB 1289</b>	<b>THIERRY</b>	<b>COURTS/JUSTICE OF PEACE</b> Provides for the appointment of a deputy constable
