HB 6	THIERRY	CRIMINAL/PROCEDURE Provides that sentences for the crime of aggravated second degree battery shall not be suspended
HB 16	WOOTON	WEAPONS/HANDGUNS Provides for the certification of concealed handgun permit instructors
HB 27	HARDY	CRIME/ABUSE Amends penalties for cruelty to juveniles when the offense involves exposure of children to controlled dangerous substances
HB 30	WOOTON	CORRECTIONS Increases the pool of employees of the Dept. of Public Safety and Corrections who are eligible to be designated as special agents
HB 42	HARDY	WEAPONS/FIREARMS Increases penalties for carrying a firearm or discharging a firearm during a parade
HB 43	HARDY	DRUGS Expands drug free zones from 1,000 feet to 2,000 feet from designated properties
HB 60	WOOTON	WEAPONS/HANDGUNS Amends concealed handgun permit laws
HB 68	BURNS, HENRY	WEAPONS/HANDGUNS Provides with respect to concealed handgun permits
HB 141	WOOTON	WEAPONS/FIREARMS Provides that applications to possess or transfer certain firearms may be filed on approved electronic forms
HB 158	WOOTON	WEAPONS/HANDGUNS Provides with respect to the issuance of concealed handgun permits
HB 348	LORUSSO	WEAPONS/FIREARMS Amends penalties imposed for a convicted felon in possession of a firearm
HB 556	WOOTON	WEAPONS/HANDGUNS Amends firearm-free zone provisions with respect to concealed handgun permit holders

HB 990	THIERRY	CORRECTIONS Amends provisions of the Inmate Rehabilitation and Workforce Development Act
HB 1260	HAZEL	WEAPONS/FIREARMS Provides with respect to the possession of a firearm or carrying a concealed weapon by a person convicted of certain felonies
HB 1272	BURNS, HENRY	WEAPONS/HANDGUNS Authorizes the use of fixed-case marking projectiles for handgun competency training
