<b>HB 139</b>	<b>HARDY</b>	<b>CONTROLLED SUBSTANCES</b> Requires a designated driver's license or identification card for individuals convicted of certain controlled dangerous substances violations
<b>HB 201</b>	<b>HINES</b>	<b>CRIME/ABUSE</b> Creates a registry of persons convicted of certain crimes against animals
<b>HB 213</b>	<b>WILLMOTT</b>	<b>CRIME/BURGLARY</b> Creates the crime of simple burglary of a law enforcement or emergency vehicle
<b>HB 219</b>	<b>ST. GERMAIN</b>	<b>CRIME</b> Creates the crime of illegally restraining a dog
<b>HB 314</b>	<b>CARMODY</b>	<b>GAMING</b> Provides technical changes for certain exceptions to gambling related crimes
<b>HB 316</b>	<b>CARMODY</b>	<b>GAMING</b> Exempts "fantasy competition" from certain gambling crimes
<b>HB 361</b>	<b>WILLMOTT</b>	<b>CRIME/BATTERY</b> Creates the crime of battery of a health care provider
<b>HB 408</b>	<b>LEGER</b>	<b>CRIME/DOGFIGHTING</b> Provides for the authorization of certain persons to euthanize dogs seized in connection with dogfighting
<b>HB 428</b>	<b>LEGER</b>	<b>ANIMALS/CRUELTY</b> Provides with respect to the seizure of animals treated cruelly
<b>HB 431</b>	<b>HARDY</b>	<b>CRIME/SEX OFFENSES</b> Provides for a life sentence for a second or subsequent conviction of molestation of a juvenile
<b>HB 502</b>	<b>BALDONE</b>	<b>CRIME</b> Creates the crime of fire-raising in a correctional facility
<b>HB 514</b>	<b>ST. GERMAIN</b>	<b>CRIME/ARSON</b> Amends the crime of simple arson
<b>HB 621</b>	<b>PEARSON</b>	<b>PARDON/PAROLE</b> Authorizes warrantless searches of persons on parole supervision by commissioned law enforcement officers
<b>HB 829</b>	<b>LIGI</b>	<b>CRIME</b> Amends the crime of cruelty to animals

<b>HB 1155</b>	<b>CONNICK</b>	<b>SEX OFFENSE/REGISTRY</b> Provides relative to sex offender registration and notification provisions
<b>HB 1314</b>	<b>HARDY</b>	<b>CRIME/SEX OFFENSES</b> Provides with respect to sex offender registration and notification requirements
<b>HB 1377</b>	<b>HINES</b>	<b>SEX OFFENSE/REGISTRY</b> Prohibits sex offenders from being within one thousand feet of a school bus stop
<b>HB 1436</b>	<b>NORTON</b>	<b>SEX OFFENSE/REGISTRY</b> Provides relative to sex offender notification requirements
<b>HB 1438</b>	<b>SMITH, GARY</b>	<b>SEX OFFENSE/REGISTRY</b> Provides for restrictions on sex offenders
