| HR 75 | ELLINGTON | HOUSE/RULES Provides with respect to the votes needed for the adoption of resolutions |
| HR 98 | HARDY | COMMITTEE STUDIES Requests the House Committee on House and Governmental Affairs to review the issue of the redistricting of courts particularly as it relates to the domicile and residency requirements of judges and judicial candidates |
| HR 102 | BURNS, TIM | PUBLIC BUILDINGS/ST CAPL Requests the House Executive Committee to consider allowing nonmembers access to the wireless Internet capabilities in House-controlled areas of the State Capitol |
| HR 104 | GALLOT | HOUSE/RULES Provides for the report of committee on a legislative instrument |
| HR 149 | SCHRODER | HOUSE/RULES Provides that the name of the requesting member of an amendment to the general appropriation bill or the capital outlay bill be public |
| HR 154 | HARRISON | HOUSE/RULES Allows the use of the supplemental vouchered allotment to supplement the salary of a legislative assistant |
| HCR 222 | SCHRODER | STATE AGENCIES Requests reports to specified legislative committees regarding the possibility of implementing a four-day work week consisting of four ten-hour days in a week |

- HCR 223 MONICA PUBLIC BUILDINGS/ST CAPL** Requests legislative sergeants at arms to require persons entering the capitol to be subject to search for weapons, with very limited exceptions
- HCR 236 JONES, ROSALIND VOTERS/VOTING** Directs the L.M.A., the Sheriffs' Association, and the Association of Chiefs of Police to report to the legislative governmental affairs committees regarding efforts to make the opportunity to vote by absentee by mail available to any incarcerated person who is eligible to vote
- SCR 2 MURRAY ETHICS** Requests the Law Institute to study changes to the Code of Governmental Ethics enacted in the 2008 extraordinary and regular sessions and to make recommendations regarding those changes.
- SB 28 MORRELL ELECTION CODE** Provides for an all-purpose "super" poll watcher. (1/1/11)
- SB 335 BROOME COUNSELING/GUIDANCE** Revises the Social Work Practice Act. (gov sig)
- SB 709 WALSWORTH LEGIS POWERS/FUNCTIONS** Provides relative to acts of the legislature. (1/1/11)
- SB 607 LONG (TBA) INSURERS** Provides for regulation and operation of certain group self-insurance funds for workers' compensation. (8/15/10) **(Subject to Rule Suspension)**
- SB 803 DONAHUE (TBA) CORONERS** Create a Coroner's Strategic Initiative for a Health Information and Intervention Program in the office of the coroner in each parish. (8/15/10) **(Subject to Rule Suspension)**
