HB 153	LAFONTA	HEALTH CARE Extends the termination date of the La. Commission on HIV, AIDS, and Hepatitis C
HB 197	MILLS (TBA)	CONTROLLED SUBSTANCES Provides relative to the Prescription Monitoring Program (Subject to rule suspension)
HB 312	SMILEY	HEALTH Allows minors at least 16 years of age to donate blood with parental consent
HB 582	BALDONE	HEALTH CARE/FACILITIES Provides exceptions to the requirement for state agencies to purchase prostheses, orthoses, and related services only from an accredited facility
HB 776	WILLMOTT	HEALTH CARE Extends until Jan. 1, 2012, the facility need review approval for licensed intermediate care facilities that are located in certain areas
HB 872	MILLS	PHARMACISTS Allows pharmacists to administer influenza immunizations
HB 960	BURFORD	BOARDS/COMMISSIONS Provides for the process by which the Board of Examiners of Nursing Facility Administrators may establish fees and costs
HB 963	KATZ	PHYSICIANS Establishes a volunteer license as a category of medical licensure issued by the La. State Board of Medical Examiners
HB 1073	MILLS (TBA)	PHARMACISTS Provides with respect to drugs of concern in the prescription monitoring program (Subject to rule suspension)
