HB 369	CONNICK	TRANSPORTATION Authorizes DOTD to use monies from the Transportation Trust Fund to fund ferries that are not connected to state roads
HB 735	WADDELL	MTR VEHICLE/DRIVER LIC Exempts citizens of certain ages from a driver's license fee increase
HB 938	JACKSON, MICHAEL	MTR VEHICLE/INSPECTION To increase emission inspection fees
HB 1339	DOWNS (TBA)	MTR VEHICLE/DRIVER LIC Provides for additional requirements and restrictions for drivers' licenses for minors (Subject to Rule Suspension)
HB 1366	CHAMPAGNE	HIGHWAYS Requires that the Department of Transportation and Development install a traffic signal at an intersection in Vermilion Parish
HB 1395	BADON, AUSTIN	PUBLIC CONTRACT/BIDS Requires the submission of information regarding subcontractors for bids with DBE participation goals
HB 1398	ELLINGTON	MOTOR VEHICLES To authorize the use of mini-trucks on roads
HB 1418	FOIL	MTR VEHICLE/TOWING Provides for holds by law enforcement agencies on motor vehicles stored at storage facilities
HB 1425	MONICA	MTR VEHICLE/TRAILERS Requires safety devices on trailers connected to motor vehicles
SB 39	MCPHERSON	TRANSPORTATION/DEV DEPT Changes the requirement for holding public hearings on the highway priority program from the DOTD to the Joint Highway Priority Construction Committee. (8/15/10)
SB 77	MCPHERSON	TRANSPORTATION/DEV DEPT Provides that the chairman of the Senate Committee on Transportation, Highways and Public Works shall serve as chairman of the board of the Louisiana Transportation Authority.

SB 616	MCPHERSON	TRAFFIC Provides relative to speed limits on highways. (8/15/10)
SB 617	MCPHERSON	MOTOR VEHICLES Prohibits impounding of a private passenger car, pickup truck, van, recreational vehicle, or motorcycle operated by Louisiana residents for a first violation except when there exists an imminent danger to the public. (8/15/10)
