HB 102	EDWARDS	CRIMINAL/RECORDS Provides with respect to the exemption of fees for certain expungement cases
HB 106	LOPINTO	CRIMINAL/RECORDS Provides for the portability of criminal background checks in certain cases involving positions with supervisory or disciplinary authority over children
HB 109	LEGER	CRIMINAL/SENTENCING Removes convictions for possession of controlled dangerous substances as prior offenses for purposes of the habitual offender law
HB 167	BALDONE	CRIMINAL/SENTENCING Provides with respect to earning pre-conviction "good time" diminution of sentence
HB 180	ROY	CRIMINAL/RECORDS Amends provisions regarding criminal background checks
HB 245	LEGER	CORRECTIONS Provides that criminal sentences shall run concurrently unless a consecutive sentence is ordered by the court
HB 444	JONES, ROSALIND	CORRECTIONS Provides limitations on the number of inmates participating in work release programs
HB 462	MILLS	DRUGS/CONTROLLED Provides relative to standards for inpatient hospitalization at Feliciana Forensic Facility when a person is charged with certain felonies and misdemeanors
HB 483	PUGH	CRIMINAL/RECORDS Authorizes the La. Real Estate Commission to access criminal history information
HB 510	BALDONE	CONTROLLED SUBSTANCES Provides relative to driving offenses while under the influence of a drug and provides for definition of "drug"
HB 549	BALDONE	CRIMINAL/PROCESS Authorizes the use of electronic signatures of offenders

HB 562	BALDONE	LAW ENFORCE/OFFICERS Expands the crime of disarming a peace officer to include the taking of all forms of law enforcement equipment
HB 564	SMITH, PATRICIA	CRIMINAL/PROCEDURE Provides for uniform expungement form
HB 607	ROY	ELDERLY Provides for the mandatory reporting of abuse of adults by financial institutions and the release of financial records
HB 795	WOOTON	CRIMINAL/RECORDS Provides relative to an employer's access to criminal history and arrest records of a potential employee
HB 867	LOPINTO	CRIMINAL/PROCEDURE Provides for the reduction of a defendant's sentence for substantial assistance in an investigation or prosecution
HB 927	GALLOT	CRIMINAL/RECORDS Provides for expungement for certain offenses under certain circumstances
HB 1393	JONES, ROSALIND	CORRECTIONS Requires DPS&C to adopt rules for uniform canteen provisions in correctional facilities
