



HB 310	WHITE	PROPERTY/EXPROPRIATION (Constitutional Amendment) Prohibits state agencies and political subdivisions from entering into cooperative endeavors with the federal government to provide funding for the taking or damaging of lands for wetlands mitigation
HB 328	WHITE	PROPERTY/EXPROPRIATION (Constitutional Amendment) Prohibits expropriation of private property for certain compensatory mitigation purposes
HB 886	HARRISON	ENVIRONMENT Provides for litter abatement and enforcement and education programs
HB 1256	CROMER	WATERWAYS Adds Bayou Liberty to the natural and scenic rivers program
HB 1258	HARRISON	ENVIRONMENT/QUALITY DEPT Provides with respect to applications for industrial facilities
HB 1265	ARMES	PROPERTY Authorizes the transfer of certain property in Vernon Parish from DOTD
HB 1266	BARRAS	PROPERTY/PUBLIC Provides for the transfer of certain state property in Iberia Parish
HB 1309	HOWARD	WATER/DRINKING WATER Provides for drinking water intakes
HB 1311	GULLORY	PUBLIC LANDS/STATE Provides for the transfer of state property to the city of Eunice
HB 1322	BARROW	ENVIRONMENT/RECYCLING Requires state agencies to implement a solid waste reduction and recycling program
HB 1336	BARRAS	BOATS/SHIPS/VESSELS Authorizes the Dept. of Wildlife and Fisheries to assign hull identification numbers to certain vessels manufactured in this state
HB 1353	BROSSETT	BRIDGES/FERRIES Transfers ownership of the Ted Hickey Bridge to DOTD
HB 1354	HILL	ANIMALS Provides relative to the sale, barter, trade, and possession of non-indigenous and poisonous snakes and constrictors
