SB 151	ADLEY	<b>INTERNET</b> Enhances the penalties for criminal and terrorists acts where the use of an Internet, virtual, street-level map is used in the commission of the crime or terrorist act. (8/15/10)
SB 374	MORRELL	<b>CRIMINAL PROCEDURE</b> Requires that time served by a habitual offender be served at hard labor. (8/15/10)
