HB 102	EDWARDS	CRIMINAL/RECORDS Provides with respect to the exemption of fees for certain expungement cases
HB 103	HARDY	CRIME Creates the crime of unlawfully wearing clothing which exposes undergarments or certain body parts
HB 104	HARDY	DWI Requires a driver who is arrested for a DWI to remain in jail 48 hours after arrest
HB 107	LOPINTO	CRIMINAL/PROCEDURE Provides with respect to the arrest or release of persons with outstanding warrants
HB 348	LORUSSO	WEAPONS/FIREARMS Amends penalties imposed for a convicted felon in possession of a firearm
HB 555	JONES, ROSALIND	CRIME/THEFT Creates a uniform system of gradations for types of theft and certain other crimes providing for misappropriation without violence
HB 563	BALDONE	CRIMINAL/SENTENCING Creates a pretrial incarceration alternative pilot program in Lafourche Parish
HB 564	SMITH, PATRICIA	CRIMINAL/PROCEDURE Provides for uniform expungement form
HB 628	GISCLAIR	CRIME Provides with respect to the crime of vehicular homicide
HB 663	LEGER	INDIGENT DEFENSE Provides for the continuous revision of delinquency proceedings
HB 795	WOOTON (TBA)	CRIMINAL/RECORDS Provides relative to an employer's access to criminal history and arrest records of a potential employee (Subject to Rule Suspension)
HB 867	LOPINTO	CRIMINAL/PROCEDURE Provides for the reduction of a defendant's sentence for substantial assistance in an investigation or prosecution

HB 1106	WHITE	JUVENILE PROCEDURE Provides relative to divestiture of juvenile jurisdiction
HB 1190	WOOTON	DWI Requires ignition interlock device to be installed on vehicles of persons who refuse to submit to chemical tests when arrested for DWI
HB 1319	HARRISON	COLLEGES/UNIVERSITIES Provides relative to compensation to institutions in the La. Community & Technical College System for providing certain educational services to inmates and personnel at state correctional facilities
HB 1412	RICHMOND	CORRECTIONS Provides with respect to electronic monitoring equipment
HB 1426	EDWARDS	GAMBLING/VIDEO POKER Amends property restrictions regarding video draw poker establishments
SCR 17	DONAHUE	CRIME/PUNISHMENT Directs the Louisiana Sentencing Commission to complete its work and report to the legislature with recommendations.
SB 52	GAUTREAUX, B.	PROBATION/PAROLE Provides for changes in the qualifications needed to serve on the parole board. (1/9/12)
SB 61	AMEDEE	CRIMINAL PROCEDURE Provide relative to digital affidavits/warrants. (8/15/10)
SB 151	ADLEY	INTERNET Enhances the penalties for criminal and terrorists acts where the use of an Internet, virtual, street-level map is used in the commission of the crime or terrorist act. (8/15/10)
SB 374	MORRELL	CRIMINAL PROCEDURE Requires that time served by a habitual offender be served at hard labor. (8/15/10)
SB 375	MORRELL	CRIME/PUNISHMENT Provides for the crime of home invasion. (8/15/10)
SB 503	CLAITOR	ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEDURE Provides that the Department of Public Safety and Corrections is the only proper party defendant involving the judicial review of department administrative decisions. (8/15/10)
SB 577	CLAITOR	PROBATION/PAROLE Provides that in petitions for judicial review of administrative decisions of the Board of Parole the only proper defendant is the board. (8/15/10)
