<b>HB 57</b>	<b>DANAHAY</b>	<b>PRIVATE INVESTIGATORS</b> Increases penalty for violation of private investigator law
<b>SB 10</b>	<b>GAUTREAUX, N.</b>	<b>CRIME/PUNISHMENT</b> Provides for certain incidents when an incarcerated prisoner must be tested for certain diseases. (8/15/10)
<b>SB 47</b>	<b>CROWE</b>	<b>PROBATION/PAROLE</b> Provides for certain probation fees paid into the Sex Offender Registry Technology Fund. (8/15/10)
<b>SB 96</b>	<b>MORRISH</b>	<b>CORRECTIONAL FACILITIES</b> Provides relative to facilities providing housing or temporary residence to individuals referred by judicial agencies. (8/15/10)
<b>SB 233</b>	<b>HEITMEIER</b>	<b>CRIMINAL PROCEDURE</b> Provides for the scope of argument and charges by the court in certain criminal proceedings. (8/15/10)
<b>SB 234</b>	<b>HEITMEIER</b>	<b>EVIDENCE</b> Provides for clarifying language relative to confession evidence. (8/15/10)
<b>SB 282</b>	<b>HEITMEIER</b>	<b>CRIMINAL PROCEDURE</b> Clarifies that to qualify as a juror a person not be under indictment for, nor convicted of a felony for which he has not been pardoned by the governor. (8/15/10)
<b>SB 574</b>	<b>CLAITOR</b>	<b>CRIMINAL PROCEDURE</b> Authorizes expungement of certain traffic offenses. (8/15/10)
<b>SB 576</b>	<b>CLAITOR</b>	<b>CRIME/PUNISHMENT</b> Provides relative to second offense possession of marijuana. (8/15/10)
<b>SB 679</b>	<b>GAUTREAUX, B.</b>	<b>PROBATION/PAROLE</b> Amends the definition of "technical violation." (8/15/10)
<b>SB 774</b>	<b>CLAITOR</b>	<b>CRIMINAL PROCEDURE</b> Provides relative to waiver of appeal in death penalty cases. (10/01/10)
