HCR 58	HARRISON	ADMINISTRATION DIVISION Directs the disaster recovery unit of the office of community development in the division of administration to provide funding for the South La. Economic Council in FY 2011-2012
HB 100	CARTER	STUDENT/ASSESSMENT Provides relative to school readiness assessment
HB 136	LORUSSO (TBA)	APPROPRIATIONS Appropriates funds to the Non-Flood Protection Asset Management Authority (Subject to Rule Suspension)
HB 143	LORUSSO (TBA)	MILITARY AFFAIRS Provides for death and disability benefits for La. National Guardsmen (Subject to Rule Suspension)
HB 306	RICHARD	STATE EMPLOYEES Requires certain reductions in the number of positions in the executive branch of state government
HB 313	SIMON	PUBLIC BLDGS/GROUNDS-ST Requires state buildings to provide suitable areas for breastfeeding and lactation
HB 364	ROY	ATHLETICS Creates a comprehensive sports injury management program for student athletics
HB 384	PEARSON	RETIREMENT/FUNDING (Constitutional Amendment) Provides for a minimum of ten percent of nonrecurring revenue be applied toward reducing the balance of the unfunded accrued liability of the state retirement systems
HB 435	PEARSON	RETIREMENT/FUNDING Provides that a minimum of 10% of nonrecurring revenue be applied toward reducing the balance of the unfunded accrued liability of the state retirement systems

HB 438	BROSSETT	APPROPRIATIONS Appropriates funds to the Non-Flood Protection Asset Management Authority
HB 516	LEGER	GAMING/REVENUE Provides relative to the casino support services contract
HB 545	BURNS, HENRY	PUBLIC CONTRACTS Provides relative to the La. Private Corrections Management Act
HB 571	ROBIDEAUX	RETIREMENT/STATE SYSTEMS Relative to state retirement systems, makes changes to provisions affected by Act No. 992 of the 2010 R.S.
HB 573	WILLMOTT	PROCUREMENT Enacts the Procurement Preference of Domestic Products Act
HB 625	SMITH, PATRICIA	APPROPRIATIONS Supplements appropriations to the General Appropriation Act
HB 644	KATZ (TBA)	CHILD DAY CARE Provides for penalties in lieu of revocation for child care facilities or child-placing agencies which violate terms of licensure or other regulations (Subject to Rule Suspension)
