| <b>HB 629</b> | <b>ELLINGTON</b>   | <b>TAX CREDITS</b> Creates the La. Entrepreneurial Assistance and Development (LEAD) Program for tax credits for venture capital investments  |
| <b>SB 13</b>  | <b>MARIONNEAUX</b> | <b>TAX/INCOME/PERSONAL</b> Removes the 50% cap on the deduction from taxable income of tuition and fees paid by a taxpayer for a dependent child to a nonpublic elementary or secondary school or to a public elementary or secondary lab school which is operated by a public college or university, making the deduction equal to the full amount paid up to \$5,000 per child. (gov sig) |
| <b>SB 21</b>  | <b>RISER</b>       | <b>TAX/SALES</b> Grants a state tax exemption for water, mineral water, carbonated water, and flavored water sold in bottles, jugs, or containers for home consumption. (10/1/11)   |
| <b>SB 30</b>  | <b>WALSWORTH</b>   | <b>REVENUE DEPARTMENT</b> Provides for donations of tax refunds to the Louisiana Bicentennial Commission through a check-off box on state income tax returns. (gov sig)   |
| <b>SB 34</b>  | <b>RISER</b>       | <b>ASSESSORS</b> Provides for the payment of certain insurance premium costs for certain retired assessors and assessors' employees in Catahoula Parish. (8/15/11)  |
| <b>SB 63</b>  | <b>MURRAY</b>      | <b>TAX/TAXATION</b> Extends income and corporation franchise tax credit for the rehabilitation of historic structures.  |
| <b>SB 72</b>  | <b>MICHOT</b>      | <b>ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT</b> To extend the deadline for application to receive tax credits or rebates relative to the Louisiana Quality Jobs Program. (8/15/11)  |
| <b>SB 112</b> | <b>ADLEY</b>       | <b>TAX/SALES</b> Exempts parish councils on aging from paying state sales and use tax. (10/1/11)  |
| <b>SB 123</b> | <b>MARTINY</b>     | <b>TAX/TAXATION</b> Changes the Digital Interactive Media Producer Tax Credit to a refundable tax credit and provides other modifications to the program. (gov sig)   |

<b>SB 134</b>	<b>CLAITOR</b>	<b>TAX/TAXATION</b> Extends the Technology Commercialization Credit and Jobs Program from December 31, 2011 to December 31, 2017 and changes it from a refundable tax credit program to a "rebate" program. (7/1/11)
<b>SB 159</b>	<b>APPEL</b>	<b>TAX/TAXATION</b> Extends the Ports of Louisiana Investor tax credit. (gov sig)
<b>SB 187</b>	<b>LONG</b>	<b>TAX/TAXATION</b> Extends Cane River Heritage tax credit to January 1, 2014. (8/15/11)
<b>SB 203</b>	<b>PETERSON</b>	<b>TAX/INCOME/PERSONAL</b> Creates an individual income tax return checkoff for donations to the Louisiana Food Bank Association. (gov sig)
<b>SB 219</b>	<b>MILLS</b>	<b>TAX EXEMPTIONS</b> Creates the Acadiana Cultural and Entertainment Special District and authorizes certain parishes within the district to provide an exemption from their sales tax for purchases by a motion picture production company for a specific state-certified movie production by that company. (gov sig)
