<b>HB 411</b>	<b>WOOTON</b>	<b>ALIENS/ILLEGAL</b> Creates the Louisiana Citizen Protection Act
<b>HB 478</b>	<b>MONTOUCET</b>	<b>RETIREMENT/STATE EMPS</b> Provides for additional accruals for adult probation and parole officers in the primary component
<b>SCR 62</b>	<b>GAUTREAUX (TBA)</b>	<b>LEGIS POWERS/FUNCTIONS</b> Express intent of the legislature to provide life and health benefits to public employees. <b>(Subject to Rule Suspension)</b>
<b>SB 1</b>	<b>ADLEY</b>	<b>MILITARY AFFAIRS</b> Provides for death and disability benefits for Louisiana National Guardsmen activated by the governor or the president. (gov sig)
<b>SB 38</b>	<b>ERDEY</b>	<b>GROUP BENEFITS PROGRAM</b> Provides coverage for developmentally disabled dependents of classified or unclassified state civil service employees by life, health or other programs sponsored by the Office of Group Benefits under certain circumstances. (8/15/11)
<b>SB 52</b>	<b>ALARIO</b>	<b>FUNDS/FUNDING</b> Provides that once the balance in the Millennium Trust reaches \$1.38 billion, 100% of the annual Tobacco Settlement Proceeds shall be dedicated to the TOPS program. (See Act)
<b>SB 53</b>	<b>ALARIO</b>	<b>FUNDS/FUNDING</b> Constitutional amendment to provide that once the balance in the Millennium Trust reaches \$1.38 billion, 100% of the annual Tobacco Settlement Proceeds shall be dedicated to the TOPS program. (2/3 - CA13s1(A))
<b>SB 69</b>	<b>NEVERS (TBA)</b>	<b>POSTSECONDARY ED</b> Creates the Northshore Technical Community College. (gov sig) <b>(Subject to Rule Suspension)</b>
<b>SB 81</b>	<b>MILLS</b>	<b>ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT</b> Creates the Louisiana Buy Local Purchase Incentive Program to promote the consumption of Louisiana agricultural products by granting incentive payments to certain restaurant establishments for purchases of Louisiana agricultural products. (gov sig)
<b>SB 83</b>	<b>DONAHUE</b>	<b>PROCUREMENT CODE</b> Authorizes the use of reverse auctions by certain political subdivisions. (7/1/11)
<b>SB 90</b>	<b>THOMPSON</b>	<b>FUNDS/FUNDING</b> Transfers certain monies from the Boll Weevil Eradication Fund to the Louisiana Agricultural Finance Authority. (gov sig)
<b>SB 113</b>	<b>CROWE</b>	<b>FUNDS/FUNDING</b> Constitutional amendment to authorize limited redirection and transfer of funds supporting appropriations and allocations from the

state general fund and dedicated funds in certain circumstances. (2/3 CA13s1(A))

- SB 114 CROWE FUNDS/FUNDING** Authorizes limited redirection and transfer of funds supporting appropriations and allocations from the state general fund and dedicated funds in certain circumstances. (2/3-CA7s10(F)(1))
- SB 131 LONG FISCAL CONTROLS** Provides for the governor's interim budget balancing authority, authorizing him to reduce certain state general fund or statutorily dedicated fund appropriations or allocations by an additional five percent. (7/1/11) (2/3-CA7s10(F)(1))
- SB 137 LONG FISCAL CONTROLS** Provides for certain budget adjustment authority upon receiving notification that a projected budget deficit exists. (7/1/11) (2/3-CA7s10(F)(1))
- SB 144 WALSWORTH FUNDS/FUNDING** Provides relative to the sunset and abolition of certain special funds in the state treasury. (7/1/11)
- SB 147 CHAISSON FUNDS/FUNDING** Constitutional amendment to provide relative to deposits into the Budget Stabilization Fund. (2/3-CA13s1(A)) (7/1/12)
- SB 171 CHAISSON FUNDS/FUNDING** Provides relative to deposits into the Budget Stabilization Fund. (See Act)
- SB 178 HEITMEIER (TBA) MEDICAID** Creates a fund for the purpose of funding the out-of-state tuition of certain students enrolled in certain medical education programs when such medical education programs are not offered in Louisiana. (gov sig) (**Subject to Rule Suspension**)
- SB 203 PETERSON TAX/INCOME/PERSONAL** Creates an individual income tax return checkoff for donations to the Louisiana Food Bank Association. (gov sig)
- SB 242 APPEL PUBLIC CONTRACTS** Requires recording of certain public work and material and supplies contracts and certain amendments, revisions, and change orders; increases fines and criminal penalties for splitting profits, fees, and commissions. (8/15/11)
