<b>HB 47</b>	<b>MACK</b>	<b>DWI</b> Provides for a minimum mandatory jail sentence for certain DWI offenses
<b>HB 74</b>	<b>SEABAUGH</b>	<b>CRIMINAL/PROCEDURE</b> Provides relative to the examination or testing of property seized pursuant to a search warrant
<b>HB 191</b>	<b>GREENE</b>	<b>CRIMINAL/JURIES</b> Authorizes courts to impanel one or more additional grand juries
<b>HB 202</b>	<b>RICHARDSON</b>	<b>JUVENILE PROCEDURE</b> Provides relative to jurisdiction over certain juvenile proceedings
<b>HB 219</b>	<b>WILLMOTT</b>	<b>CRIME</b> Increases the value of the contract for home improvement or the amount of damage caused by home improvement fraud to be consistent with theft provisions
<b>HB 240</b>	<b>BADON</b>	<b>PARDON</b> Repeals compensation provisions applicable to members of the Board of Pardons
<b>HB 243</b>	<b>LEGER</b>	<b>GAMBLING/VIDEO POKER</b> Provides with respect to suitability and licensing of three-machine video draw poker locations
<b>HB 433</b>	<b>GREENE</b>	<b>JUVENILE PROCEDURE</b> Amends procedures relative to adjudication hearings for juvenile offenders charged with crimes of violence
<b>HB 441</b>	<b>ABRAMSON</b>	<b>FAMILY VIOLENCE</b> Provides relative to the issuance of abuse prevention orders
<b>HB 518</b>	<b>LOPINTO</b>	<b>PARDON/PAROLE</b> Merges the functions and duties of the Board of Parole into the Board of Pardons and creates a committee on parole which shall be part of the Board of Pardons
<b>HB 519</b>	<b>LOPINTO</b>	<b>PARDON/PAROLE (Constitutional Amendment)</b> Merges the duties and functions of the Board of Parole into the Board of Pardons and creates the committee on parole of the Board of Pardons
<b>HB 543</b>	<b>SMITH, PATRICIA</b>	<b>PAROLE</b> Provides for parole eligibility for certain offenders sentenced to life imprisonment if certain conditions are met

<b>HB 577</b>	<b>LOPINTO</b>	<b>CHILDREN/ABUSE</b> Provides relative to the reporting of child abuse
<b>HB 594</b>	<b>LOPINTO</b>	<b>CRIMINAL/DISCOVERY</b> Provides relative to discovery procedures for certain evidence in certain criminal proceedings
<b>HB 600</b>	<b>NORTON</b>	<b>CRIME</b> Creates the crime of failure to report a missing or deceased child
<b>HB 790</b>	<b>LOPINTO</b>	<b>CRIME</b> Amends provisions of law regarding criminal street gangs
<b>HB 899</b>	<b>HUNTER</b>	<b>CRIME/THEFT</b> Provides with respect to misdemeanor threshold for certain theft offenses
<b>HB 982</b>	<b>BARROW</b>	<b>JUVENILES</b> Provides relative to the standards, licensing, and disclosure requirements of juvenile detention facilities
<b>HB 1026</b>	<b>LOPINTO</b>	<b>PARDON/PAROLE</b> Amends parole eligibility provisions applicable to certain offenders
<b>HB 1068</b>	<b>LOPINTO</b>	<b>CRIMINAL/SENTENCING</b> Provides sentencing options with respect to certain offenses
