| HB 65 | BROSSETT | CRIME Increases penalties for the crime of home invasion |
| HB 75 | MACK (TBA) | CRIME Creates the crimes of failure to report a missing or deceased child (Subject to Rule Suspension) |
| HB 86 | LOPINTO | CRIMINAL/PROCEDURE Authorizes the sharing of criminal history information on certain individuals among certain entities |
| HB 155 | LOPINTO | GAMBLING/VIDEO POKER Provides with respect to the location of qualified truck stop facilities within prohibited distances from certain properties |
| HB 167 | DIXON | CRIMINAL/PROCEDURE Increases the maximum amount of compensation awarded to wrongfully convicted persons |
| HB 228 | SMITH, PATRICIA | CRIMINAL/PROCEDURE Authorizes the earning of additional good time by certain habitual offenders for participation in certain rehabilitation and treatment programs |
| HB 249 | THOMPSON, J | SEX OFFENSE/REGISTRY Provides relative to sex offender notification requirements |
| HB 318 | JACKSON, K | CRIMINAL/SENTENCING Amends penalty provisions for certain crimes of violence |
| HB 325 | ARNOLD | INDIGENT DEFENSE Increases the special cost assessed in criminal cases in each judicial district court for the district indigent defender fund |
| HB 512 | MORENO (TBA) | EVIDENCE Prohibits any admission to criminal conduct made during an administrative sanction proceeding from being introduced as evidence (Subject to Rule Suspension) |

| HB 665 | JAMES | CORRECTIONS Provides for earning of additional good time for participation in certain programs |
| HB 718 | BISHOP, WESLEY | INDIGENT DEFENSE Increases penalties for safety belt violations in Orleans Parish with proceeds funding indigent defense |
| HB 724 | HUNTER | INDIGENT DEFENSE Provides relative to public defenders fees when a private attorney is subsequently enrolled |
| HB 728 | LOPINTO | GAMBLING/VIDEO POKER Provides with respect to the Video Draw Poker Devices Control Law |
| HB 816 | HUNTER | INDIGENT DEFENSE Increases special cost assessed to fund indigent defender services |
| HB 983 | BADON | CRIMINAL/RECORDS Authorizes local governing authorities to collect fingerprints for certain criminal background checks |
| HB 1039 | HARRISON | CRIMINAL/PROCEDURE Requires home incarceration and electronic monitoring supervision for certain convicted offenders |
| HB 1116 | BADON | CRIME Increases the minimum mandatory sentence for second offense domestic abuse battery |
| HB 1118 | MORENO | CRIME Prohibits certain persons from providing care, supervision, or guidance to children |
| HB 1124 | JACKSON, K | INDIGENT DEFENSE Provides for additional funding for the defense of indigent defendants |
| HB 1147 | ARMES | CRIME/BATTERY Creates the crime of battery on a security officer |
| HB 1156 | GREENE | CRIMINAL/BUREAU CRIML ID Provides relative to multiple requests for criminal history record information for an individual |
