SB 158	MORRELL (TBA)	EMPLOYMENT Provides whistleblower protection to employees who report the sexual abuse of minors. (8/1/12) (Subject to Rule Suspension)
SB 367	RISER	WORKERS' COMPENSATION Provides for medical examinations in workers' compensation cases. (8/1/12)
SB 386	WARD	WORKERS' COMPENSATION Provides for payment of medical benefits within 30 days rather than 60 days contingent upon medical providers' adoption and utilization of electronic billing rules and regulations. (8/1/12)
SB 520	BROOME	WORKERS' COMPENSATION To provide for death benefit awards to dependent children of deceased employee. (8/1/12)
