<b>HB 621</b>	<b>WILLIAMS, A (TBA)</b>	<b>WORKERS COMPENSATION</b> Provides for parties authorized to procure and release medical records <b>(Subject to Rule Suspension)</b>
<b>HB 669</b>	<b>BARROW (TBA)</b>	<b>WORKERS COMPENSATION</b> Provides with respect to the monetary limit for prior authorization for medical treatment <b>(Subject to Rule Suspension)</b>
<b>HB 672</b>	<b>EDWARDS (TBA)</b>	<b>WORKERS COMPENSATION</b> Provides relative to the prescriptive period for certain injuries <b>(Subject to Rule Suspension)</b>
<b>HB 733</b>	<b>LORUSSO</b>	<b>WORKERS COMPENSATION</b> Provides with respect to verification of compliance under the Worker's Compensation Act
<b>HB 1083</b>	<b>PYLANT (TBA)</b>	<b>WORKERS COMPENSATION</b> Provides relative to the forfeiture of certain benefits while incarcerated <b>(Subject to Rule Suspension)</b>
<b>SB 386</b>	<b>WARD</b>	<b>WORKERS' COMPENSATION</b> Provides for payment of medical benefits within 30 days rather than 60 days contingent upon medical providers' adoption and utilization of electronic billing rules and regulations. (8/1/12)
<b>SB 472</b>	<b>MURRAY (TBA)</b>	<b>UNEMPLOYMENT COMP</b> Prohibits certain employees of staffing services from being classified as independent contractors. (2/3-CA 7s2.1(A)) (8/1/12) <b>(Subject to Rule Suspension)</b>
<b>SB 676</b>	<b>CROWE</b>	<b>UNEMPLOYMENT COMP</b> Provides for overpayment of benefits and the recovery thereof. (CA-7s2.1(A)) (8/1/12)
