- HB 312**     **RICHARD (TBA)**     **STUDENT/SCH ATTENDANCE** Permits, rather than requires, school systems to retain supervision of suspended or expelled students using alternative education programs (**Subject to Rule Suspension**)
- HB 1136**     **RICHARD (TBA)**     **SCHOOLS/CHARTER** Provides for establishment of a specialized statewide Type 2 charter school for certain at-risk students (**Subject to Rule Suspension**)
- HB 1088**     **HENRY (TBA)**     **SCHOOLS** Provides for the establishment and administration of a targeted coordinated school health program for the purpose of reducing childhood obesity and a grant program to assist public school governing authorities with implementation (**Subject to Rule Suspension**)
