HB 83	RICHARD	PUBLIC OFFLS/EMPS Provides relative to an exception to the dual officeholding provisions applicable to education professionals
HB 88	HENSGENS	PUBLIC EMPLOYEES Prohibits political uses of public payroll withholdings and deductions
HB 206	JACKSON, G	ETHICS/NEPOTISM Provides relative to nepotism exceptions involving certain health professionals
HB 212	RICHARD	LEGISLATORS Prohibits a former legislator from being appointed to or employed in any position in state government for a period of two years following the termination of his service as a legislator
HB 241	HENSGENS	ETHICS/CODE Authorizes certain transactions between Hospital Service District No. 3 of Vermilion Parish and a board member and legal entities in which a board member owns an interest
HB 244	SMITH, PATRICIA	ETHICS/LEGISLATIVE Prohibits a former legislator from being appointed to or employed in an unclassified position in state government for a period of two years following the termination of his service as a legislator
HB 279	SIMON	DISTRICTS/HOSPITAL SERVC Removes certain restrictions relative to contracting, ownership interests, and employment applicable to members of the board of commissioners of the St. Tammany Parish Hospital Service District No. 1
HB 303	SIMON	DISTRICTS/HOSPITAL SERVC Removes certain restrictions relative to contracting and employment applicable to former members of the board of commissioners of the St. Tammany Parish Hospital Service District No. 1

HB 321	FANNIN	ETHICS/CODE Exempts certain uncompensated public servants from mandatory ethics education and training requirements in the Code of Governmental Ethics
HB 337	RICHARD	REAPPORTIONMENT (Constitutional Amendment) Provides relative to the authority for redistricting
HB 421	ST. GERMAIN	TRANSPORTATION DEPT Provides for effective date of rules promulgated by DOTD
HB 529	BARROW	ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEDURE Requires an agency to send notice of certain rules to each member of the legislature under certain circumstances
HB 767	JACKSON, G	REAPPORTIONMENT/JUDGES Provides for the composition of the 24 th Judicial District Court
HB 784	RICHARD	PUBLIC RECORDS Provides an exemption from public records law for certain documents, electronic storage devices, and the contents of electronic storage devices used by court reporters
HB 793	HUNTER	ETHICS/CODE Provides relative to certain post service restrictions on former school board members
HB 807	HUVAL	ETHICS/CODE Provides relative to the application of the Code of Governmental Ethics to certain services provided by certain insurance producers and insurance consultants
HB 1023	SEABAUGH	PUBLIC EMPLOYEES Prohibits any entity which engages in political activity from receiving public payroll withholdings or deductions
HB 1034	FOIL	ETHICS Excludes persons whose public service is limited to certain professional services from the provisions of the Code of Governmental Ethics
HB 1035	SEABAUGH	ELECTIONS/POLL WATCHERS Provides relative to super watchers
HB 1149	ARMES	PUBLIC EMPLOYEES Provides relative to reprisals against charter school employees for disclosures of improper acts
