<b>HB 810</b>	<b>JAMES</b>	<b>STATE EMPLOYEES</b> Authorizes payroll deductions for nonprofit organizations or associations
<b>HB 812</b>	<b>CHAMPAGNE</b>	<b>FUNDS/FUNDING</b> (Constitutional Amendment) Requires that any monies received by the state from lawsuits arising from the Deepwater Horizon oil spill shall be deposited into the Coastal Protection and Restoration Fund
<b>HB 838</b>	<b>CHAMPAGNE</b>	<b>FUNDS/FUNDING</b> Dedicates any state revenues received from lawsuits arising from the Deepwater Horizon oil spill be deposited into the Coastal Protection and Restoration Fund
<b>HB 860</b>	<b>GREENE</b>	<b>FUNDS/FUNDING-BUDGET,ST</b> (Constitutional Amendment) Provides with respect to appropriations and use of funds for payment of certain obligations
<b>HB 861</b>	<b>SIMON</b>	<b>CHILD DAY CARE</b> Provides relative to penalties imposed on child care facilities and child-placing agencies which violate terms of licensure and individuals or entities that operate without or in violation of a license.
<b>HB 982</b>	<b>BARROW</b>	<b>JUVENILES</b> Provides relative to the standards, licensing, and disclosure requirements of juvenile detention facilities
<b>HB 1043</b>	<b>BURNS, HENRY</b>	<b>FUNDS/FUNDING</b> Dedicates certain monies to the New Opportunities Waiver Fund
<b>HB 1044</b>	<b>KLECKLEY</b>	<b>LEGISLATIVE EXPENSES</b> Makes appropriations for the expenses of the legislature for FY 2012-2013
<b>HB 1045</b>	<b>SEABAUGH</b>	<b>LIABILITY</b> Provides for defense and indemnification of state officers and employees
<b>SB 82</b>	<b>BUFFINGTON</b>	<b>FUNDS/FUNDING</b> Constitutional amendment to except the Medicaid Trust Fund for the Elderly from certain deficit provisions. (2/3 CA13s1(A))
<b>SB 285</b>	<b>ADLEY</b>	<b>FUNDS/FUNDING</b> Dedicates a portion of certain tax receipts for fire protection at Camp Minden. (6/30/12)
<b>SB 304</b>	<b>PETERSON</b>	<b>PUBLIC BUILDINGS/GROUNDS</b> Names the new UMC/LSU Hospital in New Orleans the "Reverend Avery C. Alexander Academic Research Hospital". (gov sig)
<b>SB 352</b>	<b>MURRAY (TBA)</b>	<b>FUNDS/FUNDING</b> Establishes the Major Events Fund as a special fund in the state treasury. (7/1/12) <b>(Subject to Rule Suspension)</b>

- SB 421**      **DONAHUE**                      **FUNDS/FUNDING** Provides for an entity under the latest federal-state cooperative program for local population estimates. (7/1/12)
- SB 549**      **MILLS**                                      **FUNDS/FUNDING** Provides for appropriations from the St. Martin Parish Enterprise Fund to be made to the St. Martin Parish government for tourism and economic development. (gov sig)
- SB 652**      **CLAITOR**                                  **LOTTERIES** Provides relative to the content of annual budget reports to be submitted to the Joint Legislative Committee on the Budget by the Louisiana Lottery Corporation. (7/1/12)
- SCR 62**      **MURRAY**                                      **PUBLIC PROPERTY** Requests commissioner of administration to transfer the former insurance building site to the legislative branch for use by the legislative auditor and the legislature.
