<b>HCR 90</b>	<b>SEABAUGH</b>	<b>CRIMINAL/PROCEDURE</b> Directs the Criminal Code Committee of the La. State Law Institute to study the feasibility of assessing filing fees for applications of post-conviction relief
<b>HCR 91</b>	<b>DIXON</b>	<b>INDIAN AFFAIRS</b> Recognizes the La. Precinct of the Southern Band of the Cherokee as an Indian tribe of La.
<b>HCR 113</b>	<b>HARRISON</b>	<b>CRIMINAL/SENTENCING</b> Directs the La. Sentencing Commission to study the feasibility of requiring an offender to serve an imposed sentence through home incarceration with the use of electronic monitoring
<b>HB 239</b>	<b>SEABAUGH</b>	<b>CRIMINAL/PROCEDURE</b> Provides for the assessment of filing fees for second or subsequent applications for post conviction relief
<b>HB 318</b>	<b>JACKSON, K</b>	<b>CRIMINAL/SENTENCING</b> Amends penalty provisions for certain crimes of violence
<b>HB 983</b>	<b>BADON</b>	<b>CRIMINAL/RECORDS</b> Authorizes local governing authorities to collect fingerprints for certain criminal background checks
<b>HB 1124</b>	<b>JACKSON, K</b>	<b>INDIGENT DEFENSE</b> Provides for additional funding for the defense of indigent defendants
<b>SB 5</b>	<b>MURRAY</b>	<b>CRIMINAL PROCEDURE</b> Provides relative to trial by jury. (8/1/12)
<b>SB 96</b>	<b>MORRELL</b>	<b>CRIMINAL RECORDS</b> Changes the name of the offender tracking system. (8/1/12)
<b>SB 105</b>	<b>MORRELL</b>	<b>PUBLIC SFTY/CORRECT DEPT</b> Provides a monetary penalty for the introduction of contraband into a correctional facility by a visitor. (8/1/12)
<b>SB 156</b>	<b>MURRAY</b>	<b>CHILDREN'S CODE</b> Provides for academic plan for children committed to the Department of Public Safety and Corrections. (gov sig)

<b>SB 213</b>	<b>BROWN, TROY</b>	<b>CRIMINAL RECORDS</b> Adds the La. Department of Insurance as an entity which is allowed to receive expunged records. (8/1/12)
<b>SB 264</b>	<b>MORRELL</b>	<b>CORRECTIONAL FACILITIES</b> Provides relative to the Inmate Welfare Fund. (8/1/12)
<b>SB 329</b>	<b>MORRELL</b>	<b>CRIMINAL PROCEDURE</b> Prohibits release on own recognizance for certain offenses. (8/1/12)
<b>SB 377</b>	<b>SMITH, GARY</b>	<b>SEX OFFENSES</b> Provides for reporting changes of name, address, and other information by certain offenders required to register with law enforcement officials. (8/1/12)
<b>SB 403</b>	<b>MORRELL</b>	<b>CRIMINAL RECORDS</b> Provides relative to expungement of certain records. (8/1/12)
<b>SB 531</b>	<b>PEACOCK</b>	<b>TRESPASS</b> Provides for forfeiture of and payment to landowners for wildlife killed in the course of trespass on private property. (8/1/12)
<b>SB 616</b>	<b>MORRELL</b>	<b>CRIME/PUNISHMENT</b> Prohibits automated sales suppression devices. (8/1/12)
<b>SB 633</b>	<b>JOHNS</b>	<b>CRIME/PUNISHMENT</b> Provides for the crime of unauthorized use of supplemental nutrition assistance program (SNAP) benefits and penalties. (1/1/13)
