<b>SB 103</b>	<b>NEVERS</b>	<b>POSTSECONDARY ED</b> Limits the number of hours required to earn a baccalaureate degree. (8/1/12)
<b>SB 104</b>	<b>NEVERS</b>	<b>POSTSECONDARY ED</b> Provides relative to postsecondary education articulation and transfer requirements. (gov sig)
<b>SB 745</b>	<b>NEVERS</b>	<b>SCHOOLS</b> Provides for consolidation of two or more school systems. (8/1/12)
<b>SB 759</b>	<b>NEVERS</b>	<b>STUDENTS</b> Provides relative to the care of students with diabetes. (gov sig)
<b>SB 284</b>	<b>CORTEZ</b>	<b>COMMUNITY TECH SYSTEM</b> Merges certain La. Technical College campuses with South Louisiana Community College. (gov sig)
<b>SB 247</b>	<b>LONG</b>	<b>POSTSECONDARY ED</b> Creates the Central La. Technical Community College. (gov sig)
<b>SB 685</b>	<b>LONG</b>	<b>SCHOOLS</b> Requires the parents or guardians of public school children to attend at least one parent-teacher conference per year. (8/1/12)
<b>SCR 17</b>	<b>DORSEY-COLOMB</b>	<b>POSTSECONDARY ED</b> Requests the Board of Regents and LCTCS to study the feasibility of merging Capital Area Technical College and Baton Rouge Community College.
<b>SCR 60</b>	<b>PERRY</b>	<b>BESE</b> Requests BESE/DOE to develop a comprehensive curriculum for a high school communications/speech course to prepare students to communicate effectively.
<b>SB 305</b>	<b>WHITE</b>	<b>SCHOOLS</b> Constitutional amendment to remove geographic limitations on the legislature's authority to create new school boards and provide relative to the financing of public education. (2/3 - CA13sl(A))
<b>SB 507</b>	<b>MORRELL</b>	<b>STUDENTS</b> Permits student athletes to participate in certain camps or showcase opportunities and provides for eligibility of student athletes who transfer from one nonpublic school to another nonpublic school. (gov sig)
