| <b>HB 612</b> | <b>GREENE</b>         | <b>STUDENT/LOANS-SCHOLARSHP</b> Permits use of TOPS awards at eligible La. institutions by otherwise qualified students who graduated from out-of-state colleges or universities   |
| <b>HB 650</b> | <b>CARTER</b>         | <b>GOVERNMENT ORGANIZATION</b> Provides relative to the organization of the state Department of Education  |
| <b>HB 89</b>  | <b>HOFFMANN (TBA)</b> | <b>STUDENTS</b> Provides relative to the use of seclusion and physical restraint to address the behavior of certain students <b>(Subject to Rule Suspension)</b>   |
