| <b>HB 243</b> | <b>CARTER</b>         | <b>STUDENT/LOANS-SCHOLARSHIP</b> Provides relative to the eligibility of certain students who graduate from certain out-of-state or out-of-country high schools to receive a Taylor Opportunity Program for Students (TOPS) award                                    |
| <b>HB 612</b> | <b>GREENE</b>         | <b>STUDENT/LOANS-SCHOLARSHIP</b> Permits use of TOPS awards at eligible La. institutions by otherwise qualified students who graduated from out-of-state colleges or universities  |
| <b>HB 207</b> | <b>CARMODY</b>        | <b>PUBLIC BLDGS/GROUNDS-ST</b> Authorizes each public postsecondary education management board to name a building at an institution under its supervision and management in honor of a living person   |
| <b>HB 79</b>  | <b>HENSGENS</b>       | <b>SCHOOLS</b> Provides relative to school crisis management and response plans  |
| <b>HB 155</b> | <b>COX</b>            | <b>SCHOOLS</b> Provides relative to school safety, security, and crisis  |
| <b>HB 224</b> | <b>HOLLIS</b>         | <b>SCHOOL BUS DRIVERS</b> Provides for the removal of a school bus driver convicted for certain offenses relative to operating a vehicle while intoxicated   |
| <b>HB 206</b> | <b>REYNOLDS</b>       | <b>SCHOOLS/BOARDS</b> Removes geographic limitations on the legislature's authority to create new school boards and on provisions relative to financing education  |
| <b>HB 160</b> | <b>REYNOLDS (TBA)</b> | <b>TEACHERS/EVALUATION</b> Delays implementation of certain teacher evaluation program requirements and requires legislative approval of the value-added teacher assessment model prior to implementation of the requirements<br><b>(Subject to Rule Suspension)</b> |
| <b>HB 659</b> | <b>THOMPSON, J</b>    | <b>EDUCATION</b> Provides relative to reporting, instructional, and other requirements for school employees, school governing authorities, and schools   |
