HB 85	BADON (TBA)	STATE EMPLOYEES Prohibits discrimination in state employment based on sexual identification (Subject to Rule Suspension)
HB 88	CHAMPAGNE	ELECTED OFFICIALS/TERMS (Constitutional Amendment) Provides term limits for certain statewide elected officials
HB 191	BISHOP, STUART	ELECTIONS/ABSENTEE VOTE Requires the secretary of state to take action necessary to allow certain classes of voters to vote absentee
HB 250	DANAHAY	ETHICS Exempts former public servants who served less than a certain amount of time during a year from mandatory ethics training requirements
HB 264	FOIL	PUBLIC EMPLOYEES Excludes persons whose public service is limited to certain professional services from the provisions of the Code of Governmental Ethics
HB 318	WILLIAMS, A	REAPPORTIONMENT/JUDGES Provides for the election sections for City Court of Baton Rouge and for the number of judges elected from such sections
HB 387	SCHRODER	ETHICS/CODE Protects public employees from reprisal for providing information to a legislator or legislative committee upon request
HB 479	BARRAS	ETHICS Provides an exception to annual ethics training requirements for certain hospital employees
HB 485	WHITNEY	ELECTIONS/CONGRESSIONAL Provides for the qualifying period for congressional elections
HB 490	CHAMPAGNE	LOCAL OFFICIALS Provides relative to reports concerning compensation of certain local public officers and employees
HB 538	SCHRODER	PUBLIC BLDGS/GROUNDS-ST Provides relative to security and the allocation and use of space within the state capitol complex

HB 553	FRANKLIN	REAPPORTIONMENT/JUDGES Provides for election sections in the City Court of Lake Charles
HB 649	IVEY	ELECTIONS Provides relative to federal elections
HB 665	BARRAS	ELECTIONS Provides relative to absentee by mail and early voting
