| HB 206 | REYNOLDS | SCHOOLS/BOARDS (Constitutional Amendment) Removes geographic limitations on the legislature's authority to create new school boards and on provisions relative to financing education (<i>Technical Review of Ballot Language Only</i>) |
| HB 426 | ARMES (TBA) | WILDLIFE & FISHERIES CMN (Constitutional Amendment) Adds members to the Wildlife and Fisheries Commission (<i>Technical Review of Ballot Language Only</i>) (Subject to Rule Suspension) |
