<b>HB 154</b>	<b>SMITH, PATRICIA</b>	<b>CRIMINAL/SENTENCING</b> Provides penalties relative to persons aiding and abetting in the commission of a crime and provides for the procedure by which an aider and abettor may be resentedenced
<b>HB 266</b>	<b>THIERRY</b>	<b>JUDGMENTS/CRIMINAL</b> Provides procedures for use of electronic mail to send notice of bond forfeiture
<b>HB 277</b>	<b>LAMBERT</b>	<b>WEAPONS/FIREARMS</b> Repeals provisions of law regarding prior approval for the transfer of certain firearms
<b>HB 309</b>	<b>KLECKLEY</b>	<b>CRIMINAL/SENTENCING</b> Authorizes the use of electronic monitoring for work release programs operated by the sheriff
<b>HB 385</b>	<b>HODGES</b>	<b>CRIMINAL/PROCEDURE</b> Amends provisions of law regarding post-conviction relief
<b>HB 423</b>	<b>BILLIOT</b>	<b>SEX OFFENSE/REGISTRY</b> Provides relative to petitions for injunctive relief or declaratory judgments regarding the registration and notification requirements of sex offenders
<b>HB 440</b>	<b>BILLIOT</b>	<b>SEX OFFENSE/REGISTRY</b> Provides relative to sex offender registration and notification
<b>HB 497</b>	<b>MORENO</b>	<b>CRIME/ABUSE</b> Increases the maximum term of imprisonment for a first and second conviction of domestic abuse battery
<b>SB 6</b>	<b>ALLAIN</b>	<b>CRIME/PUNISHMENT</b> Provides relative to the crime of unauthorized entry of a place of business. (gov sig)
<b>SB 8</b>	<b>GALLOT</b>	<b>CRIME/PUNISHMENT</b> Authorizes sheriffs to use prisoners for manual labor upon churches and other religious buildings. (gov sig)
<b>SB 32</b>	<b>CROWE</b>	<b>CRIMINAL PROCEDURE</b> Provides for special consideration for veterans who are convicted of a crime. (8/1/13)

<b>SB 43</b>	<b>WHITE</b>	<b>WEAPONS</b> Provides relative to the crime of manufacture and possession of a bomb.(gov sig)
<b>SB 60</b>	<b>ADLEY</b>	<b>CRIME/PUNISHMENT</b> Creates the crime of false personation of a veteran or veteran-owned business. (gov sig)
<b>SB 72</b>	<b>THOMPSON, F</b>	<b>CRIME/PUNISHMENT</b> Provides relative to disturbing the peace at funerals. (gov sig)
<b>SB 113</b>	<b>GALLOT</b>	<b>COURTS</b> Provides relative to the LA Public Defender Board and certain employees.(gov sig)
<b>SB 141</b>	<b>BROWN, TROY</b>	<b>VIDEO POKER</b> Provides relative to the temporary placement of video poker devices.(gov sig)
