_____	HB 112	RICHARD	LEGISLATIVE SESSIONS (Constitutional Amendment) Provides relative to the length of regular sessions in odd-numbered years and the consideration of certain measures in such sessions
_____	HB 252	BURNS, TIM	DISTRICTS/ECONOMIC DEVEL Provides relative to the application of certain ethics code provisions to certain members of the board of commissioners of the St. Tammany Parish Development District
_____	HB 292	ABRAMSON	CONSTITUTION/CONVENTION Provides for calling a limited constitutional convention for fiscal purposes and preparations therefor
_____	HB 296	CONNICK	ELECTIONS Provides for an automatic recount in elections when the number of absentee by mail and early voting ballots could make a difference in the outcome of the election
_____	HB 373	CARTER	LEGISLATIVE SESSIONS (Constitutional Amendment) Provides relative to legislative sessions and bill introduction limits
_____	HB 374	GEYMANN	BESE (Constitutional Amendment) Provides for the election of all members of the State

_____	HB 391	RICHARD	LOCAL GOVERNMENT Relative to the revision of local government laws pursuant to HCR No. 218 of the 2009 Regular Session, transfers the Law Enforcement Executive Management Institute from the governor's office to the Dept. of Public Safety and Corrections and provides for redesignation of provisions from Title 33 to Title 40
_____	HB 485	SMITH, P.	CIVIL SERVICE Prohibits certain questions regarding criminal history during the employment process for certain positions
_____	HB 500	BERTHELOT	ETHICS/CODE Allows a public servant to accept gifts valued at twenty-five dollars or less, up to an aggregate value of seventy-five dollars from any one person in a calendar year
_____	HB 626	ABRAMSON	APPROPRIATIONS Requires certain quasi public and nongovernmental entities to submit information to the legislative auditor and be approved by the Joint Legislative Committee on the Budget prior to receiving state monies or assistance
_____	HB 786	LANDRY, N.	SCHOOLS/BOARDS Provides relative to the election of members of the Lafayette Parish School Board
_____	HB 858	BARROW	STATE AGENCIES Provides that an action by a state agency which results in the termination of one hundred or more employees or a change in the parish in which one hundred or more employees report to work shall not be effective or enforceable unless it meets certain requirements
_____	HB 1030	THOMPSON, J	ELECTIONS Repeals additional fees imposed on candidates by political party committees
