HB 89	RITCHIE	TAX CREDITS Reduces the amount of the inventory tax credit
 HB 366	ADAMS	TAX CREDITS Changes certain refundable tax credits to nonrefundable tax credits
 HB 484	MORRIS, JAY	TAX CREDITS Reduces the amount of the tax credit for ad valorem taxes paid on inventory
HB 532	STOKES	TAX CREDITS Provides for the carry forward rather than the refund of a certain portion of the tax credit for ad valorem taxes paid on inventory
 HB 565	LEGER	TAX/SALES & USE Suspends a certain portion of state sales and use tax exemptions
 HB 613	LEGER	TAX/AD VALOREM-EXEMPTION (Constitutional Amendment) Phases-in over a five year period an exemption for items constituting business inventory
 HB 620	STOKES	TAX/AD VALOREM TAX (Constitutional Amendment) Phases-in over a four year period an exemption for items constituting business inventory
 HB 635	JACKSON	TAX/TAX REBATES Reduces all tax rebates
 HB 729	LEGER	TAX/TAXATION Phases out inventory tax credits

 HB 768	MORRIS, JAY	TAX/SALES-USE, STATE Dedicates the avails of the existing one percent state sales and use tax for the support of public elementary through post-secondary education
 HB 805	ADAMS	TAX CREDITS Provides for the carry forward rather than the refund of the tax credits for ad valorem taxes paid to local governments
