_____	<b>HB 496</b>	<b>WILLMOTT</b>	<b>PRESCRIPTION</b> Provides relative to certain prescriptive periods applicable to the reinscription of mortgages
_____	<b>HB 706</b>	<b>MIGUEZ</b>	<b>LIABILITY/CIVIL</b> Provides a limitation of liability for certain facilities operated by nonprofit youth organizations
